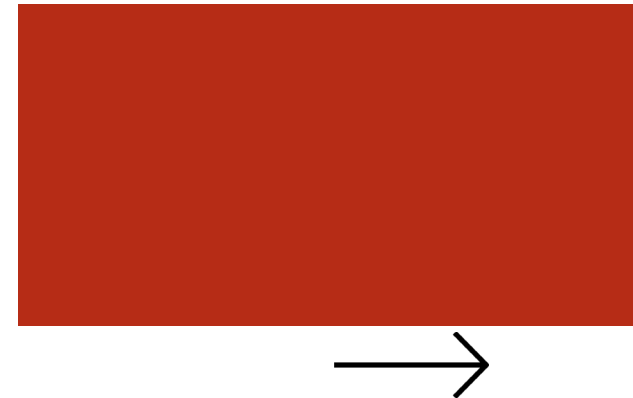
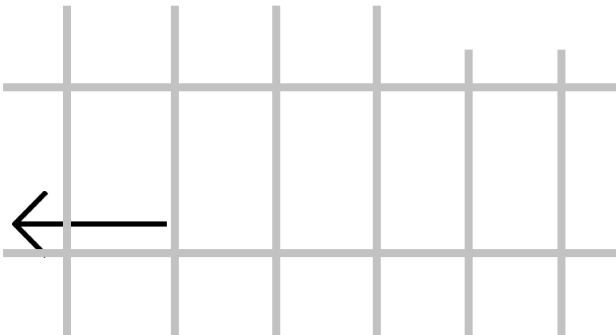
Why we recommend moving from Edgenuity to Edmentum (For a Pilot Experience)



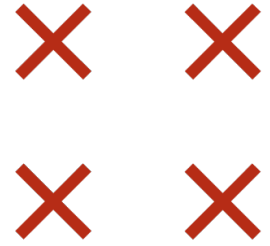


Key Challenges with Edgenuity

- Not intuitive for students and families
- Support coordination was difficult
- Staff often acted as intermediaries between families and vendor support
- High levels of student and family frustration
- Increased staff time dedicated to troubleshooting



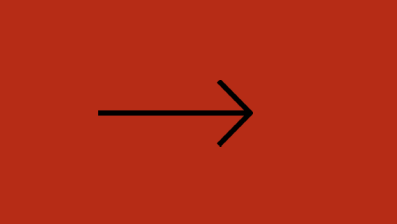
Student Outcome Concerns

Accessibility & Program Alignment Issues

Student Outcome Concerns (IDEA Focal Group)

-34 Fail/Drop/Incomplete
-58 Completed credits

67% Achievement rate

Accessibility & Program Alignment Issues

- Previously available IDEA support software was unavailable (Odysseyware)
- Limited accessibility tools and accommodations
- Quarter-based structure conflicted with our semester model
- Restrictions on number of simultaneous course enrollments
- Elective offerings did not align with our program needs
