

Cooperative Intergovernmental Agreement Between:

I. Introduction

- a. This agreement is made by and between the Board of Education of the Oregon Community Unit School District #220 (hereafter referred to as District #220) the Board of Education of the Winnebago School District #323 (hereafter referred to as District #323) and the Board of Education of the Meridian School District #223 (hereafter referred to as District #223).
- b. District #220 will serve as the host school and will assume responsibility for operating and administering the Co-op Boys & Girls Bowling Program
- c. This agreement will be for the 2026-27 school year. Any or all parts of this agreement will be renewable by mutual agreement between District #220, District #323 and District #223.
- d. The bowling teams will be referred to as the Oregon Hawks bowling teams.

II. Transportation

- a. Each school district will be responsible for determining transportation policies and procedures for their respective athletes in terms of getting athletes to practices and home events who are members of the Cooperative Bowling teams.
- b. Transportation to contests will be the responsibility of District #220, the host school. Depending on date and location, contest transportation will originate at either the host school or home bowling center, proceed directly to the contest, and return to either the host school or home bowling center.
- c. Athletes from District #323 and #223 will be expected to arrange their own transportation to and from the host school or home bowling center for all practices and home contests.
- d. Athletes from District #323 and #223 may ride District #220 transportation to and from all away contests provided they are present at departure time.

III. Supervision

- a. Supervision and organization for the athletic contests and practices shall be the responsibility of District #220.
- b. District #220 shall be responsible for the supervision of the student athletes while they are involved in the activity.

IV. Eligibility

- a. Athletes will compete under the eligibility guidelines of their respective schools, in compliance with IHSA guidelines.
- b. Athletes will be subject to their respective school's Extra-Curricular Code of Conduct. In addition, students will be subject to policies and regulations of their respective districts.

V. Awards

- a. The criteria for determining who receives awards will be determined by District #220 coaching staff.

VI. Insurance

- a. All participants will be required to have insurance statements given to District #220, indicating that insurance available to the student through the school or insurance through their parent/guardian either covers them. No athlete may practice or participate until this document is received by District #220.

VII. Physicals

- a. Copies of mandatory physicals will be on file in the respective Athletic Director's office or school office. Copies will be furnished to District #220 upon request. No athlete may practice or participate until the physical is turned in to the respective office.

VIII. Liability

- a. Liability for all students using transportation shall be borne by whichever district is responsible for that event.
- b. Premises liability shall be borne by District #220 for each particular activity upon the student's arrival at the host school site and shall continue until departure from the host school site.

IX. Contest Sites

- a. Contest sites will be the responsibility of District #220.

X. Financial Agreement

- a. District #220 will pay all coaches salaries, officials salaries, stipends to workers, maintenance, and transportation to away contests.
- b. District #220 will provide uniforms.

- c. All athletes (or their home district) will be expected to pay the District #220 activity fee.
- d. All athletes (or their home district) will be expected to pay the Bowling Center participation fee.

XI. Coaches

- a. District #220 will be responsible for hiring the head coach and assistant coaches. Volunteer coaches can be approved at the discretion of District #220.

XII. Review of Agreement

- a. This agreement shall be in effect for a one –year period commencing October 1, 2026 and will extend through June 30, 2027 This agreement will be reviewed during the 2026-27 school year.
