Background Information

The Board of Trustees shall establish a local School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) to assist the district in ensuring that local community values are reflected in the district's health education instruction. Education Code 28.004(a)

The Board is required to approve the membership of the Council prior to the first meeting. A majority of members must be persons who are parents of students enrolled in the district and who are not employed by the district. We are also recommending two high school students to serve on the Council.
