Background Information

All Weatherford Extracurricular Booster Clubs are governed by WISD Board Policy and University Interscholastic League (UIL) guidelines. By UIL guidelines, all clubs must produce periodic financial statements itemizing all receipts and expenditures. These statements are available to the general club membership and kept on file at the school. Funds raised by the booster clubs are used to support school activities. Money given to the school cannot be earmarked for any particular expense. Booster clubs may make recommendations, but cash or other valuable consideration must be given to the school to use at its discretion. In WISD, club finances pay for banquets, in-season meals for out-of-district travel, equipment, and other expenses not provided for by the Extracurricular Department budget. Annually, the Board of Trustees has requested all WISD Booster Clubs to submit a summary of their financial records for review.
