TITLE: **Approval of Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with
Town of Oro Valley for School Safety Program and Additional School
Resource Officer**

BACKGROUND:

On July 14, 2026, Amphitheater Governing Board approved an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) between the District and the Town of Oro Valley that provided School Resource Officers (SRO's) to four Amphitheater schools within the boundaries of the Town of Oro Valley. The IGA was based on the Arizona Department of Education's (ADE) approval of Amphitheater's School Safety Program Grant application.

Subsequent to the Governing Board's approval of the original IGA, ADE approved an additional request that was submitted as part of the initial grant application. The approval will provide an additional SRO at a fifth Amphitheater school. The additional allocation requires an amendment to the IGA approved on July 14, 2026.

The amendment modifies the original Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Town of Oro Valley Police Department permitted the Department to provide four (4) Police Officers to act as School Resource Officers to the District through June 30, 2027. The attached amendment increases the SROs permitted from four (4) to five (5) School Resource Officers. The specific modifications are reflected:

Paragraph 1 is replaced in its entirety with the following

The purpose of this Agreement is to establish the terms and conditions under which the Town will provide five (5) SROs to the District.

Paragraph 5 a is replaced in its entirety with the following:

The District agrees to pay the Town \$593,111.00 towards the salary and benefits for the SROs in consideration for the services provided by the Town under this Agreement. The District maximum should not exceed \$593,111.00 to include overtime, SRO related training and other expenses related to the SRO positions.

These funds will come directly from the School Safety Grant. The Town will cover the remaining costs for the SRO position.

The amendment has been reviewed and approved by legal counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

This item is presented for the Board's action. The administration recommends approval of the attached amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement.
