Background Information

The State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR) provide an annual measure of student achievement and academic growth based on the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). STAAR results provide valuable information regarding students' mastery of grade-level content and serve as an important measure of academic performance across campuses and the district.

In addition to measuring individual student performance, STAAR results are a key component of the Texas A–F Accountability System. The state accountability system evaluates districts and campuses across multiple areas, including student achievement, school progress, and the performance of student groups. Federal accountability requirements provide an additional layer of identification and support for campuses based on the performance and progress of all students and specific student groups.

To maintain transparency and support continuous improvement, the District will present an overview of the 2026 STAAR results and state and federal accountability outcomes. This update will highlight district and campus performance, year-over-year progress, areas of significant growth, and opportunities for continued improvement. Together, these results provide a comprehensive view of academic progress and help guide instructional priorities and targeted supports for the 2026–2027 school year.
