ACTION

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Beginning with the 2026-27 school year, each school system must annually submit a board-approved certification of compliance to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) no later than September 30 of each school year. Passed during the 89th Legislative Session, SB 12 addressed parental rights in public education and requires certification of compliance with provisions of the Education Code regarding (1) instruction on controversial issues and (2) diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) duties.

The annual certification must be approved by a majority vote of the board of trustees at a public meeting that includes an opportunity for public testimony and for which notice was posted on the school system's website at least seven days before the meeting; be submitted electronically to TEA; and include the required information outlined in TEC, §39.008(b)(2).
