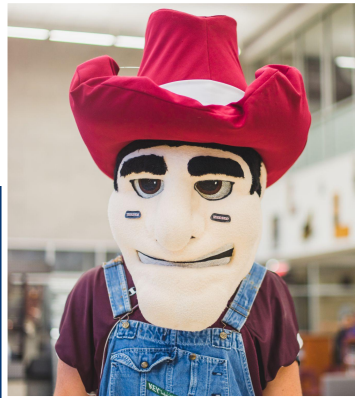
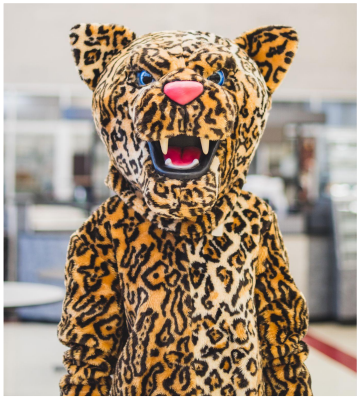




Professional Learning Plan 2026-2029

Purpose

- The purpose of the Professional Learning Plan is to support growth and meaningful reflection of practitioners to support LISD's vision, mission, and goals. By connecting curriculum design, instruction, and LISD's core goals we ensure every professional learning experience directly drives the impact on student success.
- Learning is an intentional, ongoing, and systematic process aligned with district, campus, and individual goals that impact student learning and professional growth.





Background

- SB 1267 requires the Board to annually review the State Board for Educator (SBEC) clearinghouse regarding best practices and industry recommendations for professional development and adopt a professional development policy based on the training recommendations in the clearinghouse.
- Current practices already address these specific learning needs. The changes recommended adding these specific professional learning opportunities to be specifically listed in the district learning plan. These recommendations were added and remain.



Highlights Of Professional Learning

Below are the areas of focus which were included in the plan to address state required trainings as stated in the TEA Clearinghouse list.

- Suicide Prevention
- Building skills related to managing emotions, establishing and maintaining positive relationships, and responsible decision making
- Bullying and Cyberbullying and Positive Youth Development
- Health and Safety
- Human Trafficking
- Trauma Informed Care
- Technology Safety
- Epinephrine Auto-Injector Training - As needed per campus with appropriate personnel



Highlights Of Professional Learning

LISD also provides other yearly recommended trainings that address other specific district needs.

- These needs are reviewed yearly and adjusted as needed.
- Examples Include:
 - Supporting staff mental health literacy to promote earlier intervention and improve outcomes for students
 - Social Media
 - AI
 - Mandatory Reporting



Updates And Highlights 2026-2027

- Updates and changes were made to the Professional Learning Plan to reflect the district's focus and the implementation of the updated Long Range Plan and the current strategies.
- Updates include:
