Background Information:

The purpose of this board agenda item is to present to the MISD Board of Trustees for consideration of approval the campus improvement plans (CIPs) that each campus leadership team has developed for the 2026-2027 school year. Each spring of the current school year, campus leaders begin to develop a plan to address the needs of students and staff. The CIPs reflect an analysis of achievement, attendance, and discipline data, along with gathering feedback from teachers, parents/guardians, students, and staff to pinpoint what is working well and what needs improvement. Based on this input, the plan outlines specific goals and actions to address areas targeted for improvement. CIPs are carefully crafted to prioritize the most pressing needs and set clear steps for making positive changes. Campus leadership will engage in progress monitoring in October, January, March, and June.
