

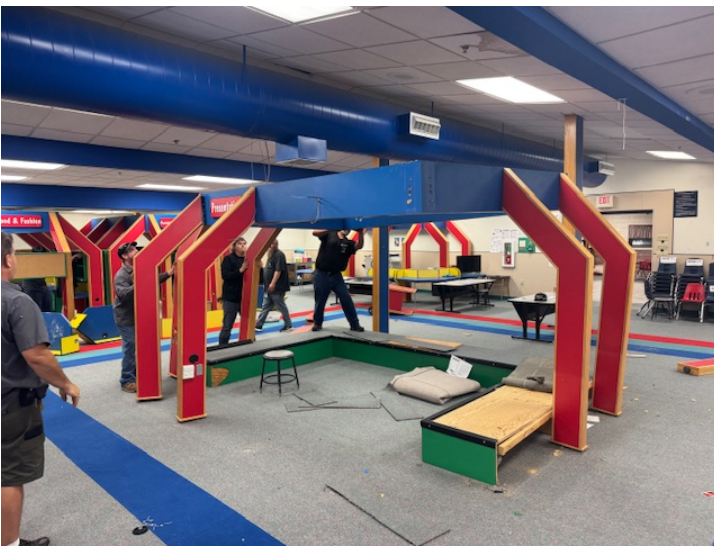


KAUFMAN ISD - MAINTENANCE REPORT

Here is the SUMMER PROJECT RECAP for 2026:

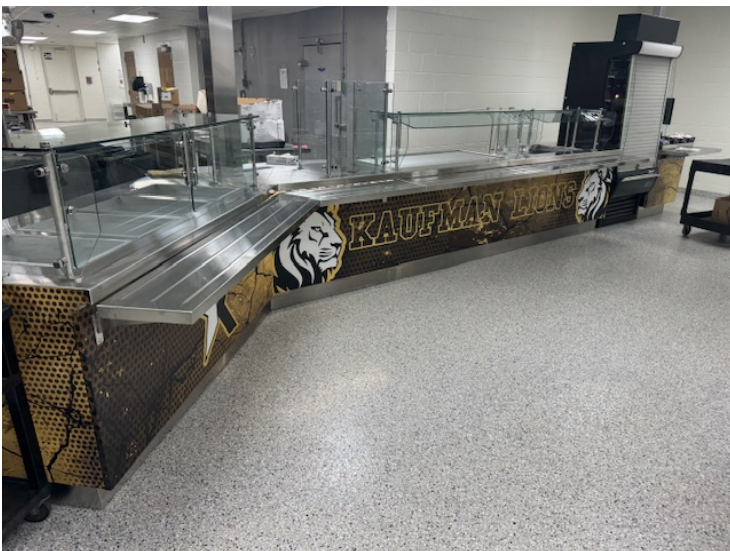

A kitchen remodel was done at the high school. The kitchen was completely cleared, cleaned, repainted and the floor was changed from tile to a special epoxy. New serving lines were installed.





The AUX gym restrooms at the high school have also been through a complete renovation this summer. The wall tile was upgraded with a more modern design and the floor tile was replace with epoxy. New automated sinks were added as well.

The old asphalt drive leading to the band lot was replaced over the summer. The road was replaced with 4000 PSI concrete which will hold up much better to the bus traffic in that area.



The crew build 3 new offices at Monday Elementary this summer. The new offices will house specialists and provide space for tutoring labs and small groups.
