Agenda Item: Consider Report on Purchasing Cooperatives Fees and Rebates

Summary:

Terrell ISD has active memberships in 23 purchasing cooperatives.

Texas Education Code 44.031(b) requires that “any management fees paid to cooperative purchasing organizations must be presented in a written report and submitted annually in an open meeting of the Board of Trustees of the School District.”

Most Cooperatives have either no membership or waived membership fees. The few that charge a fee are low-cost membership fees.

The total membership fees paid for 2025-2026 were \$3,277.50.

Total rebates received were \$13,213.18. The District is actively increasing the use of these cooperatives that provide rebates in efforts to increase the rebate each year.
