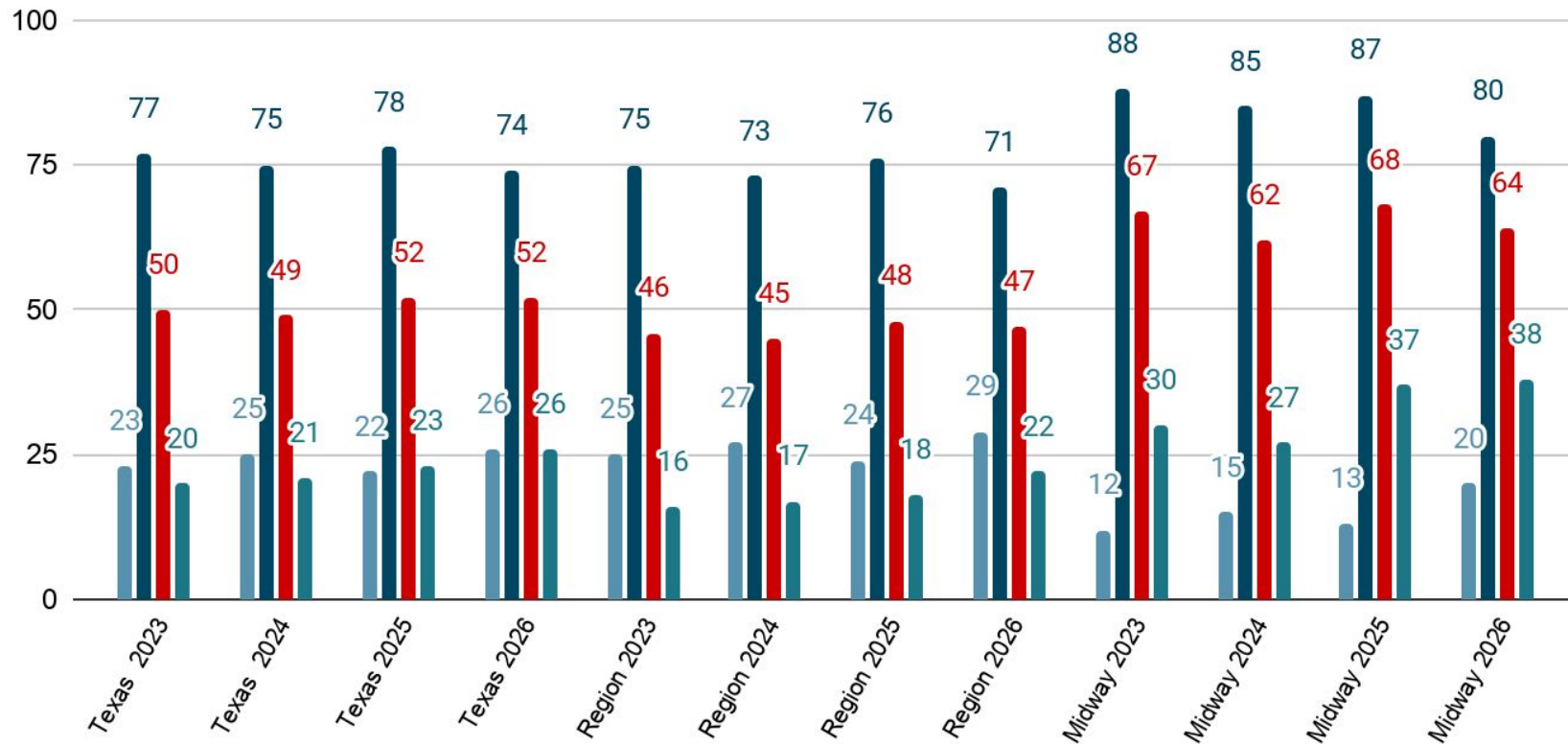

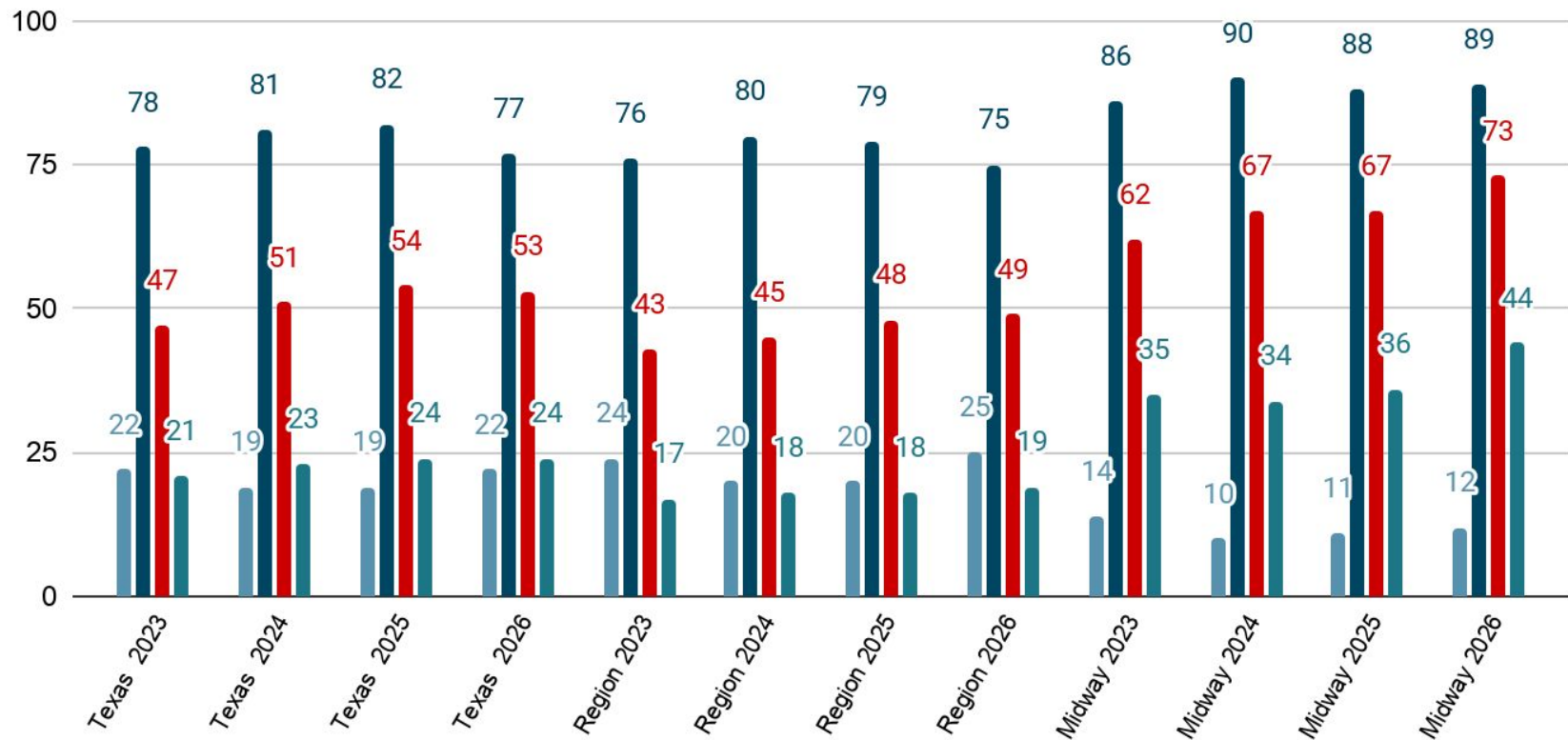

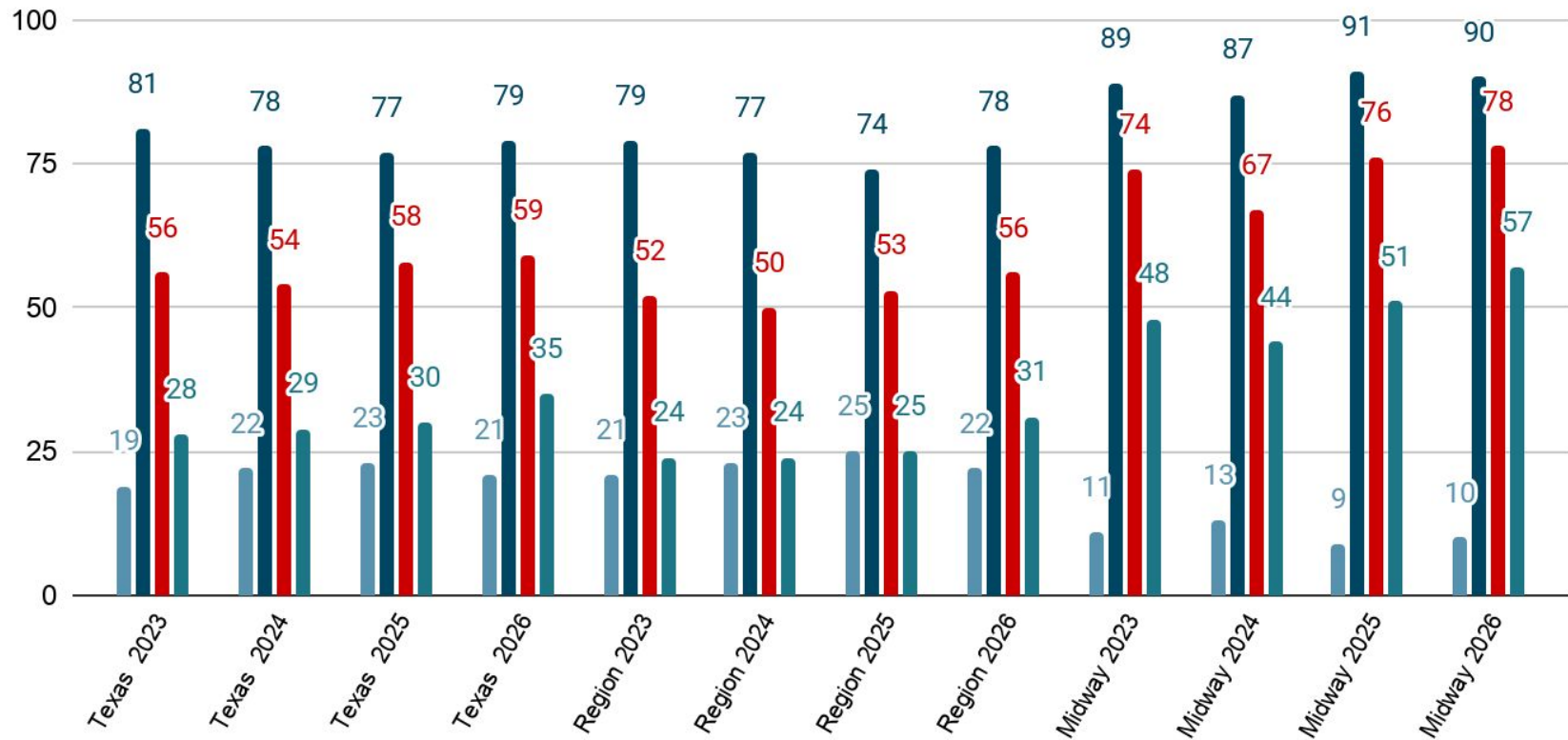

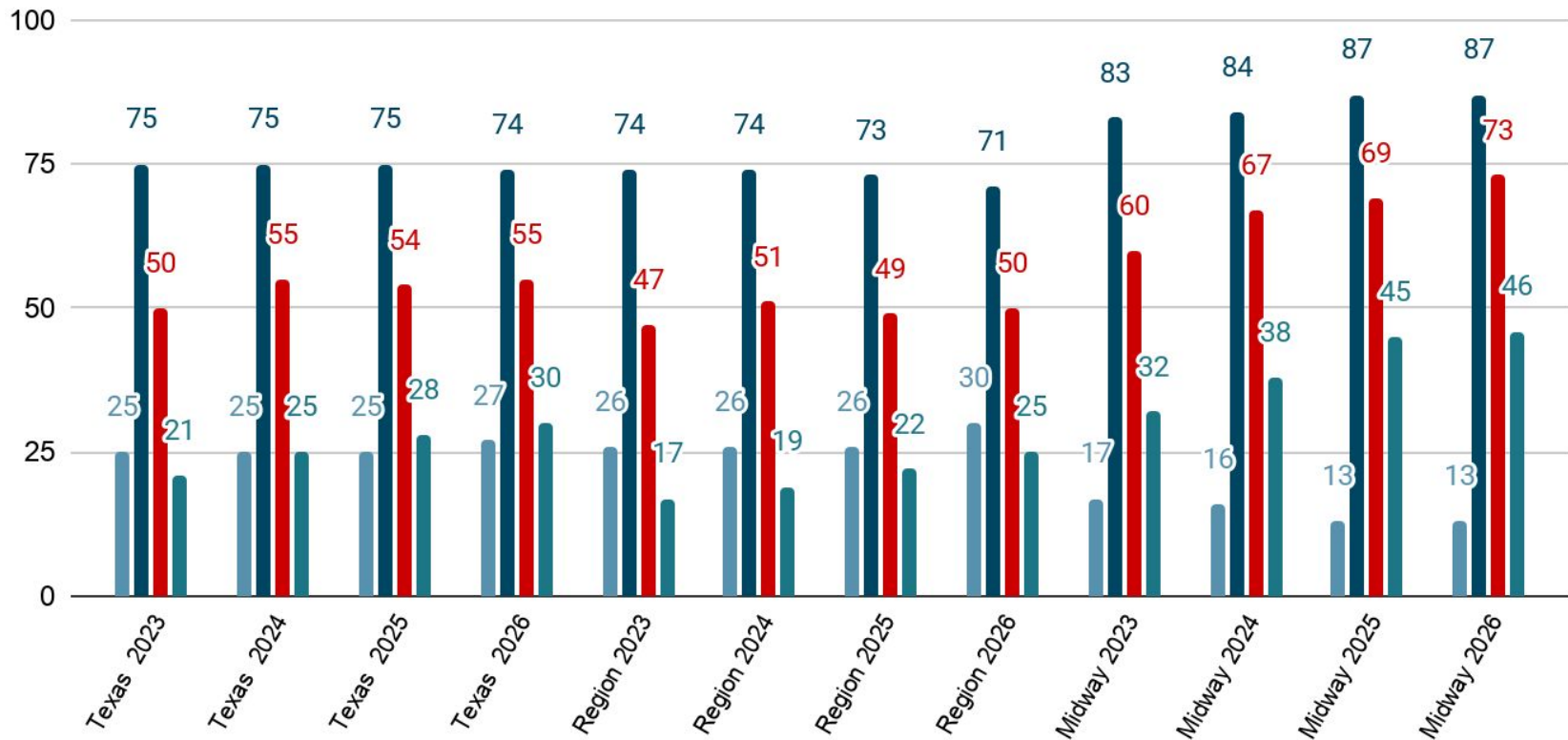

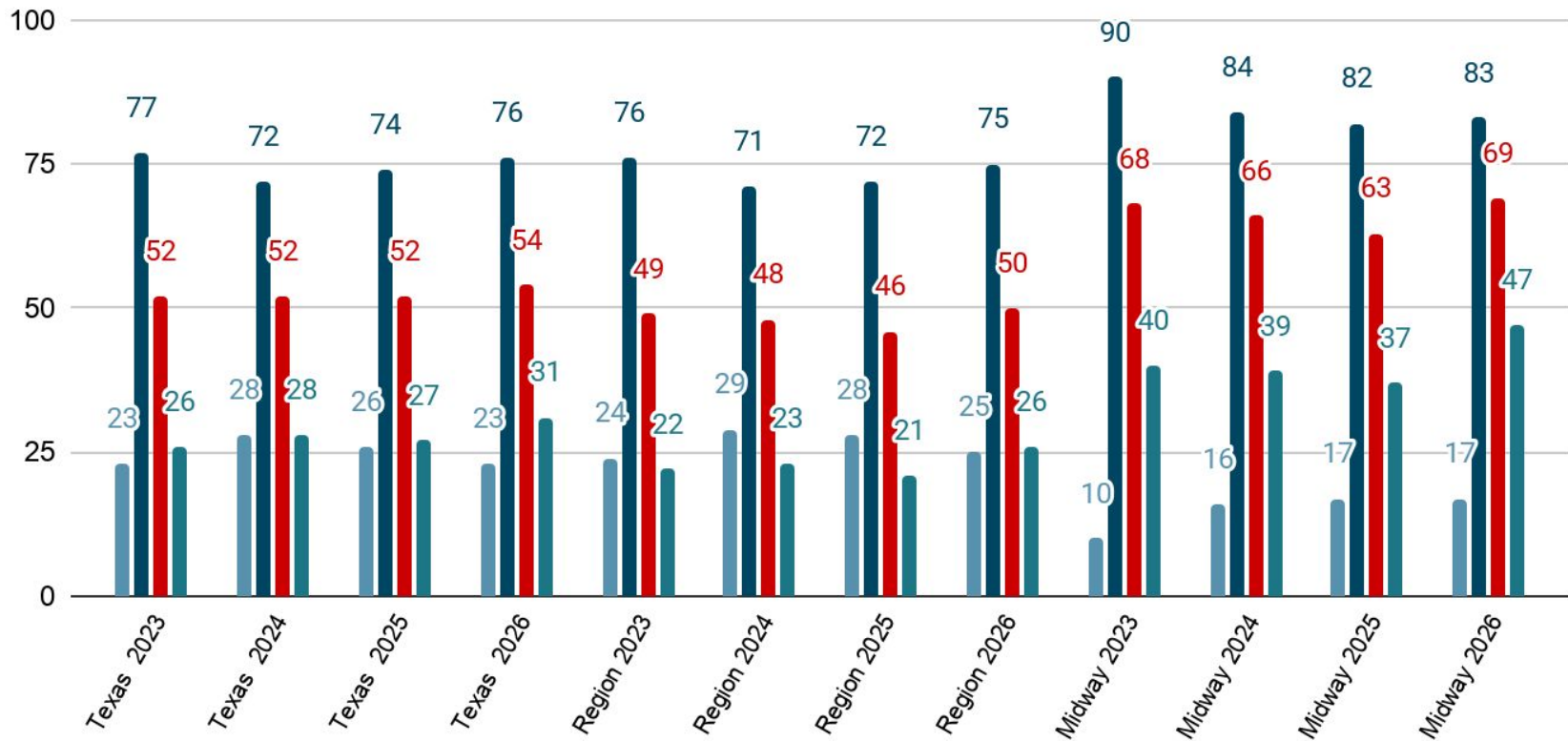

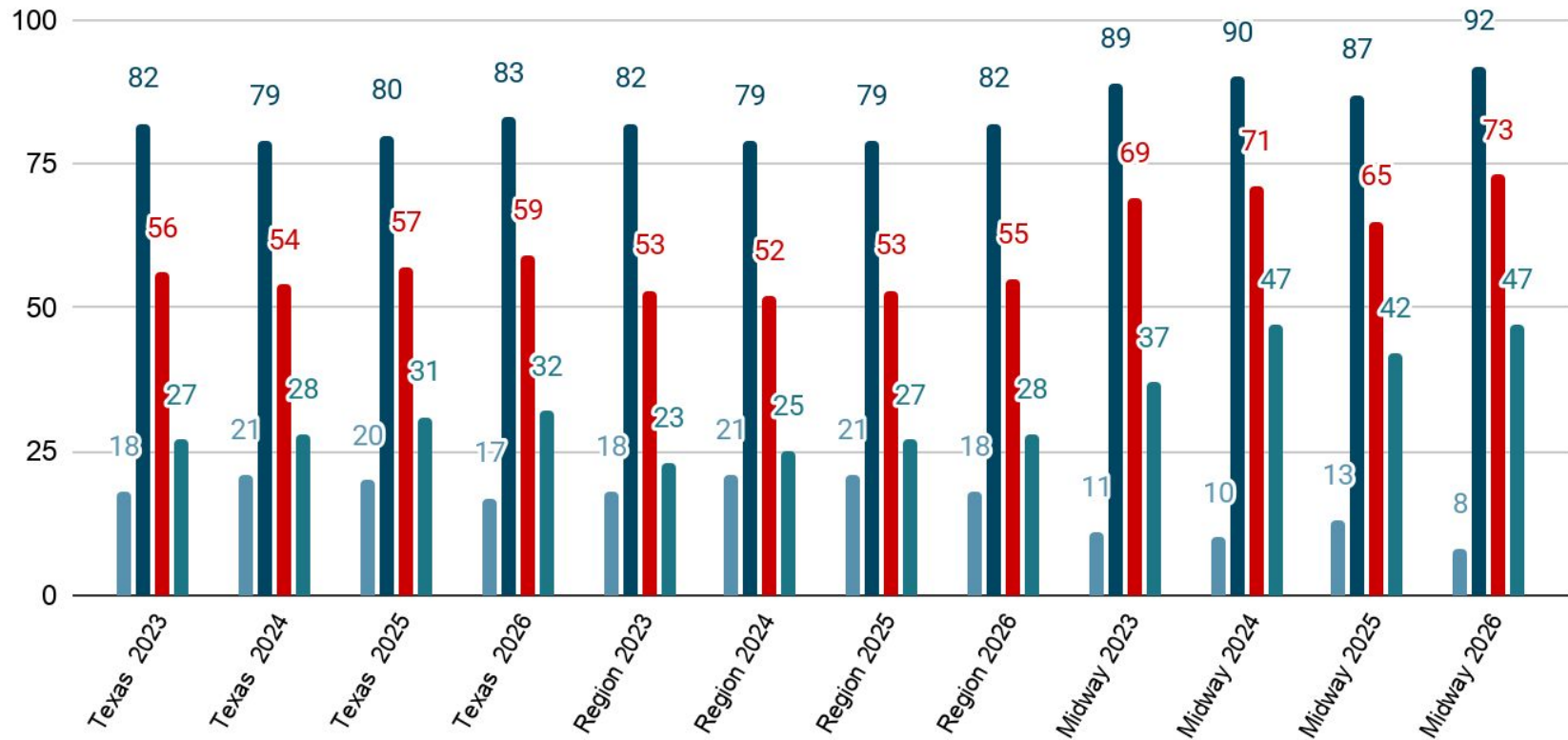

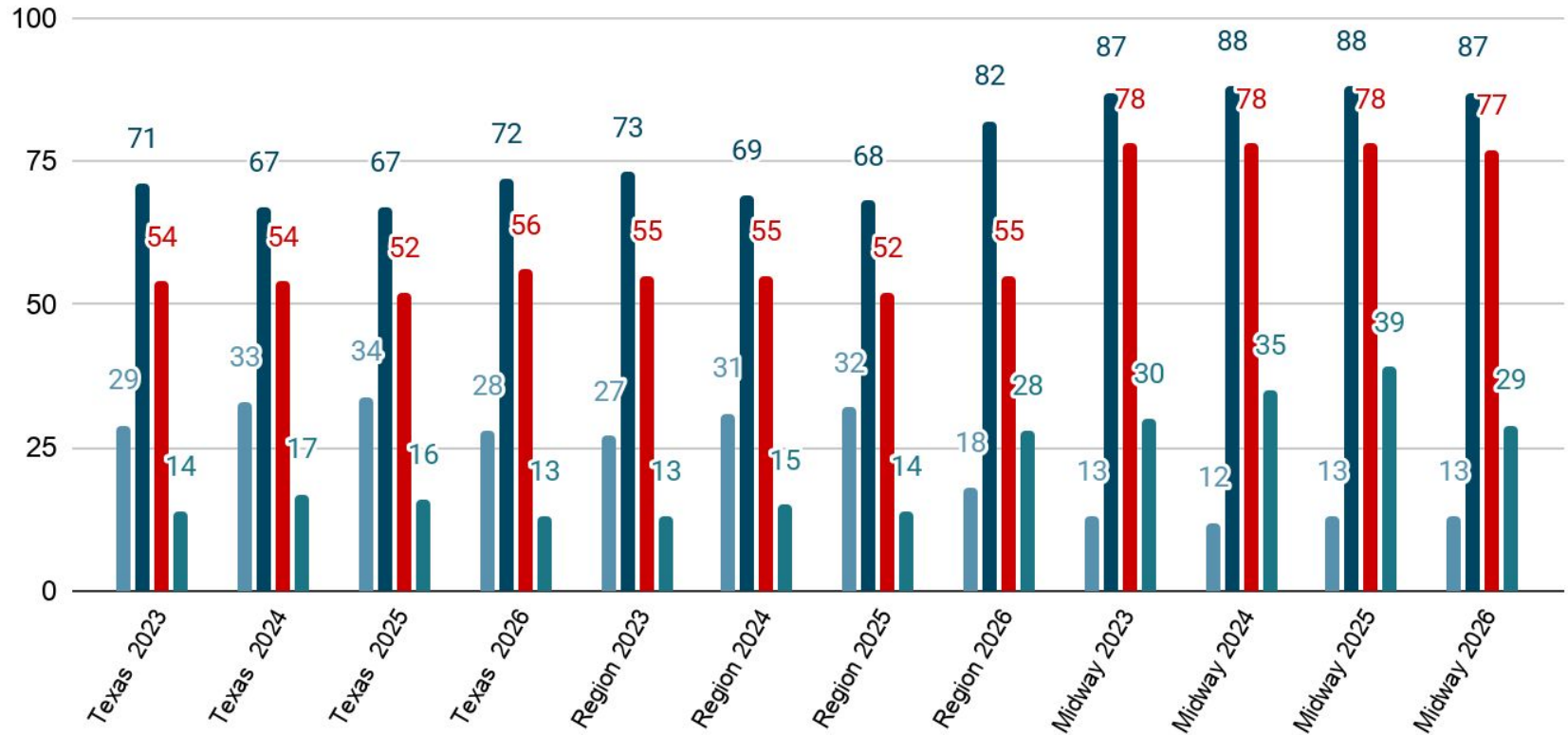

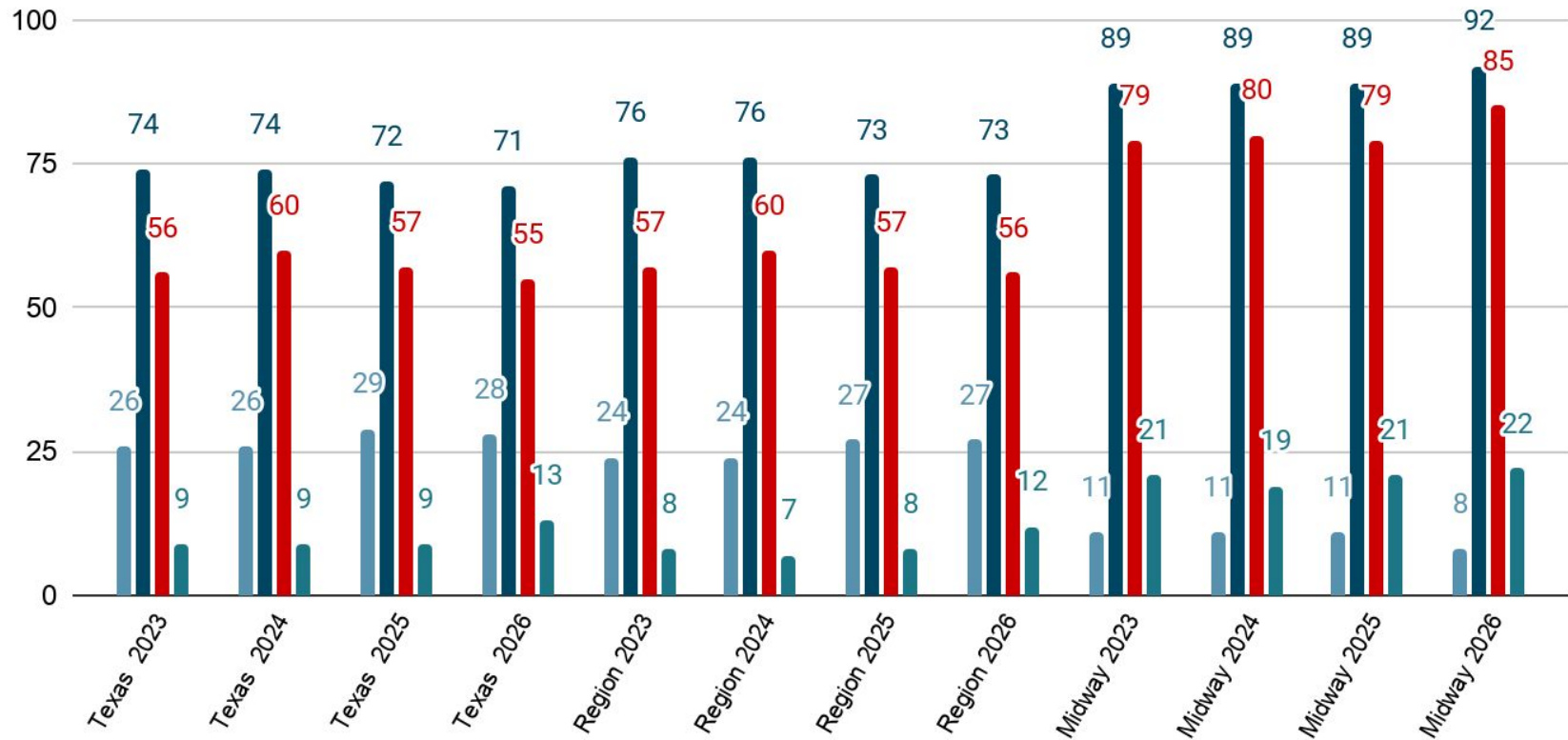

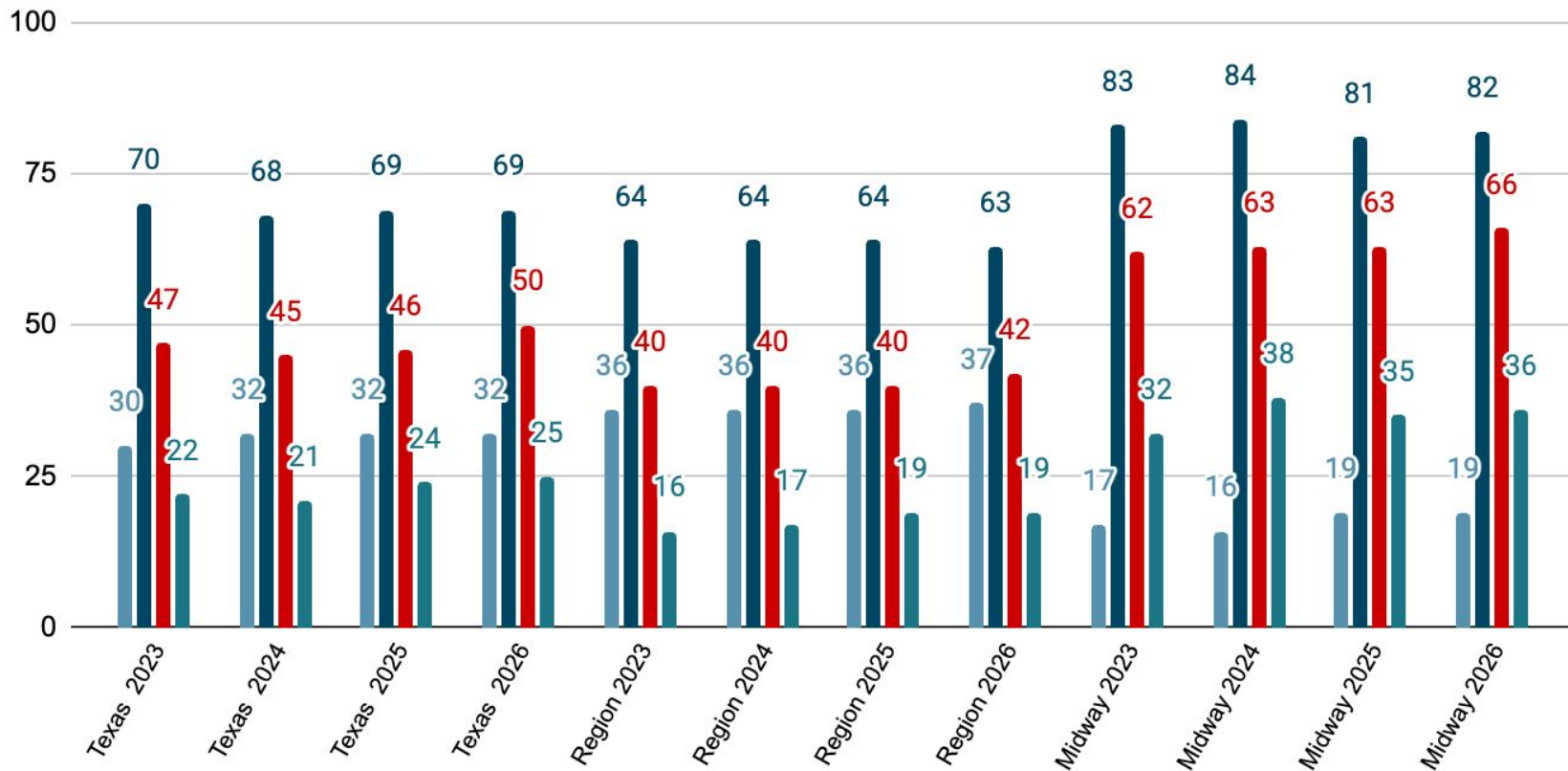

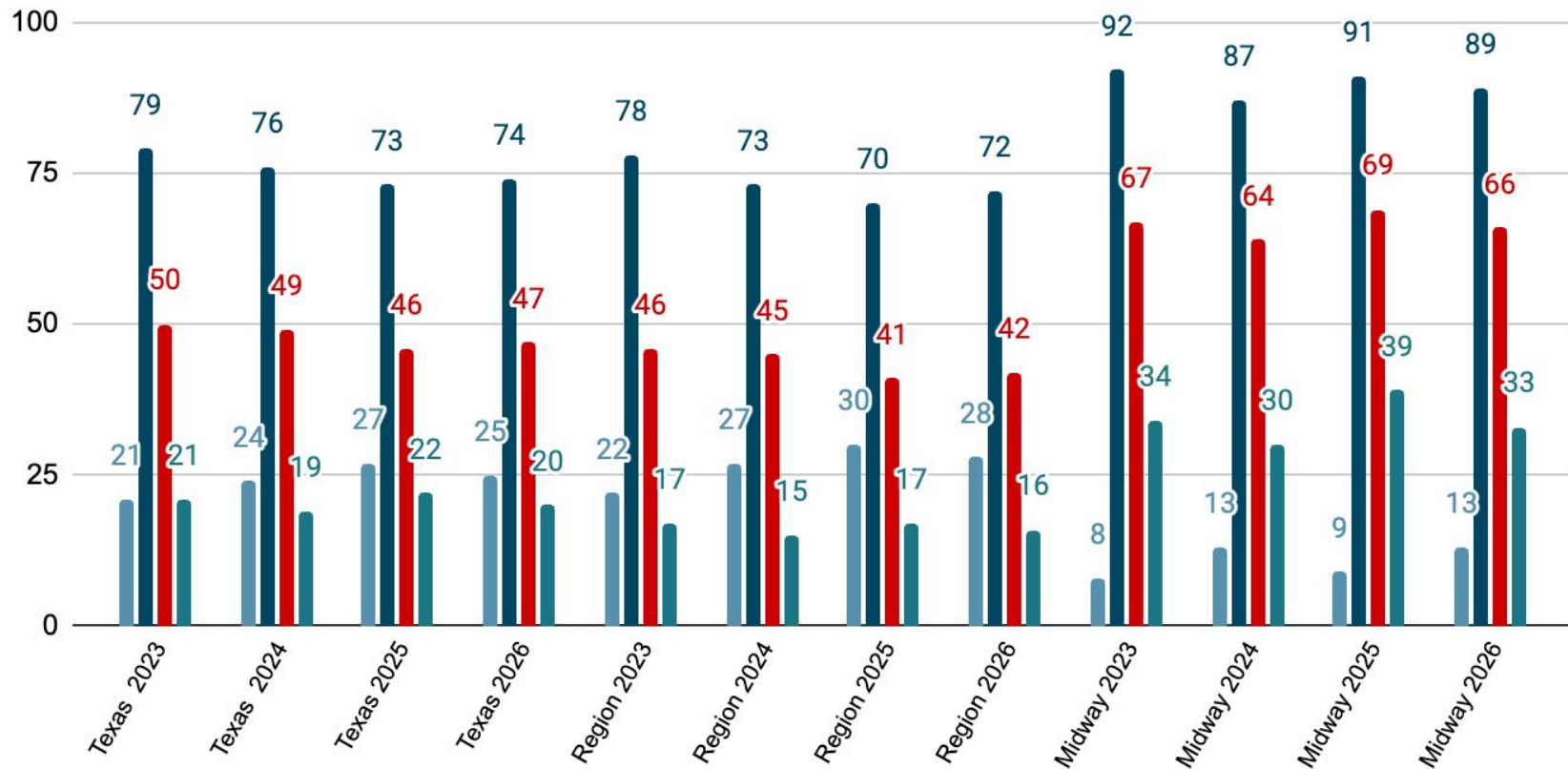

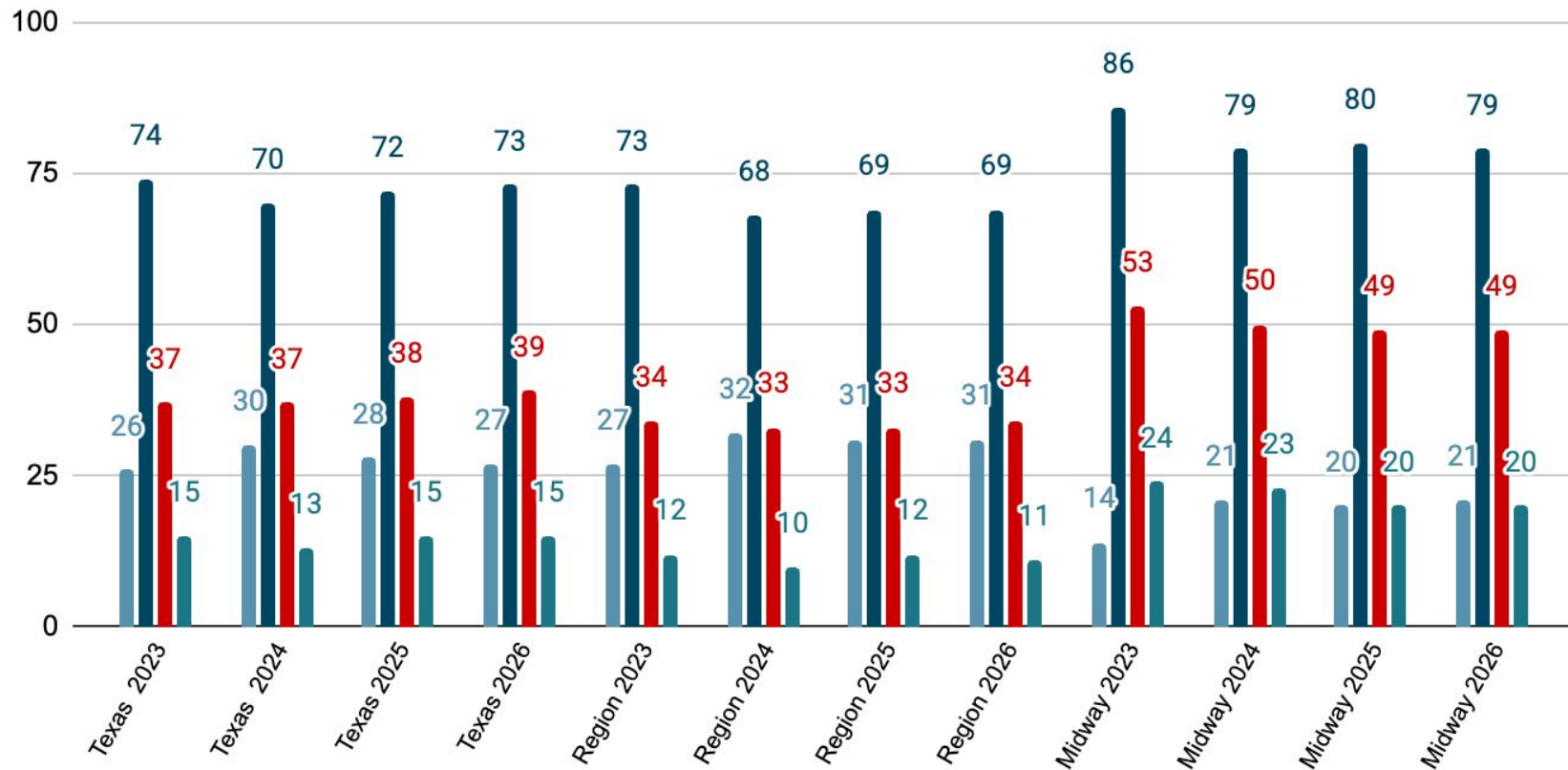

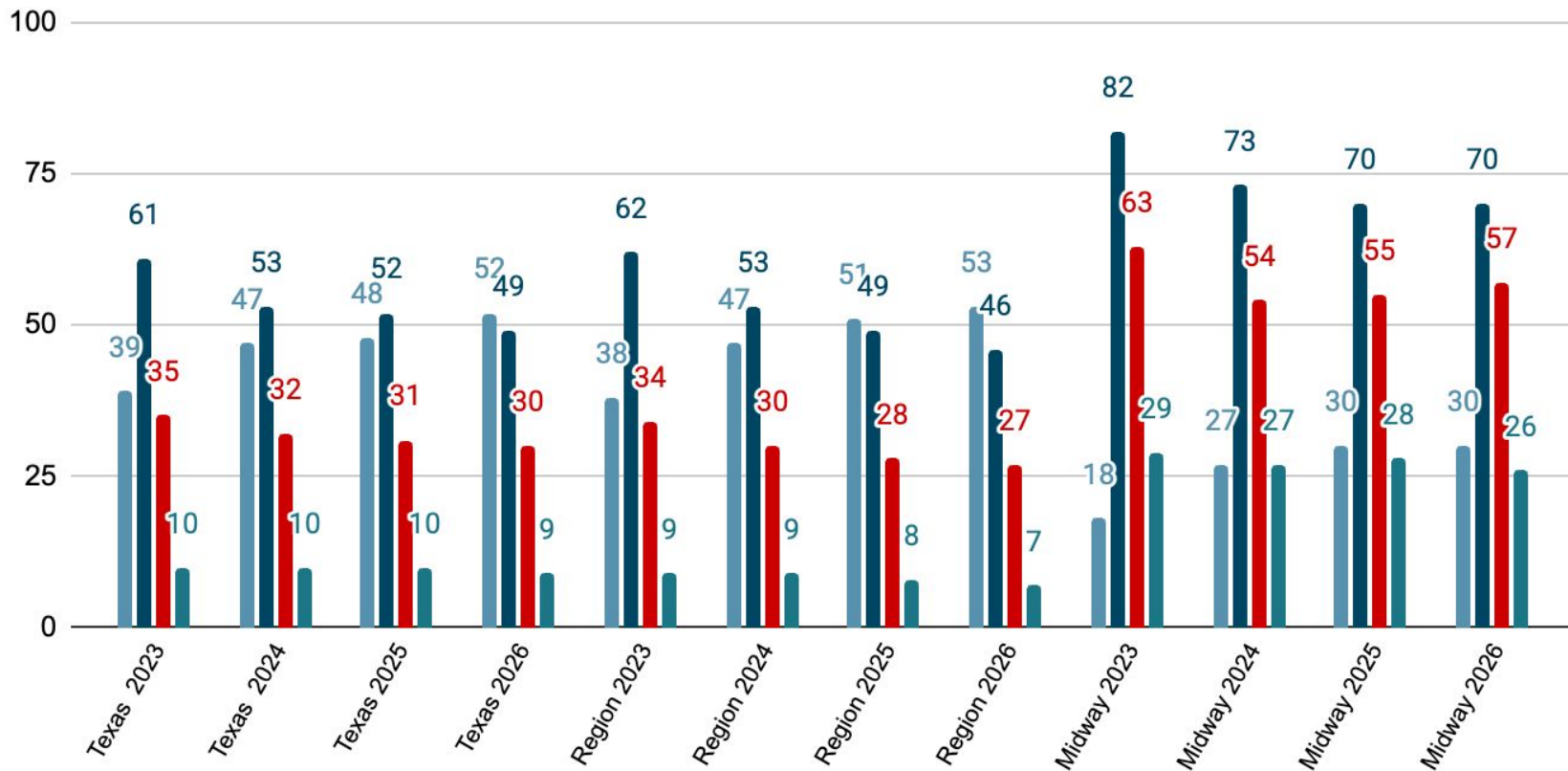

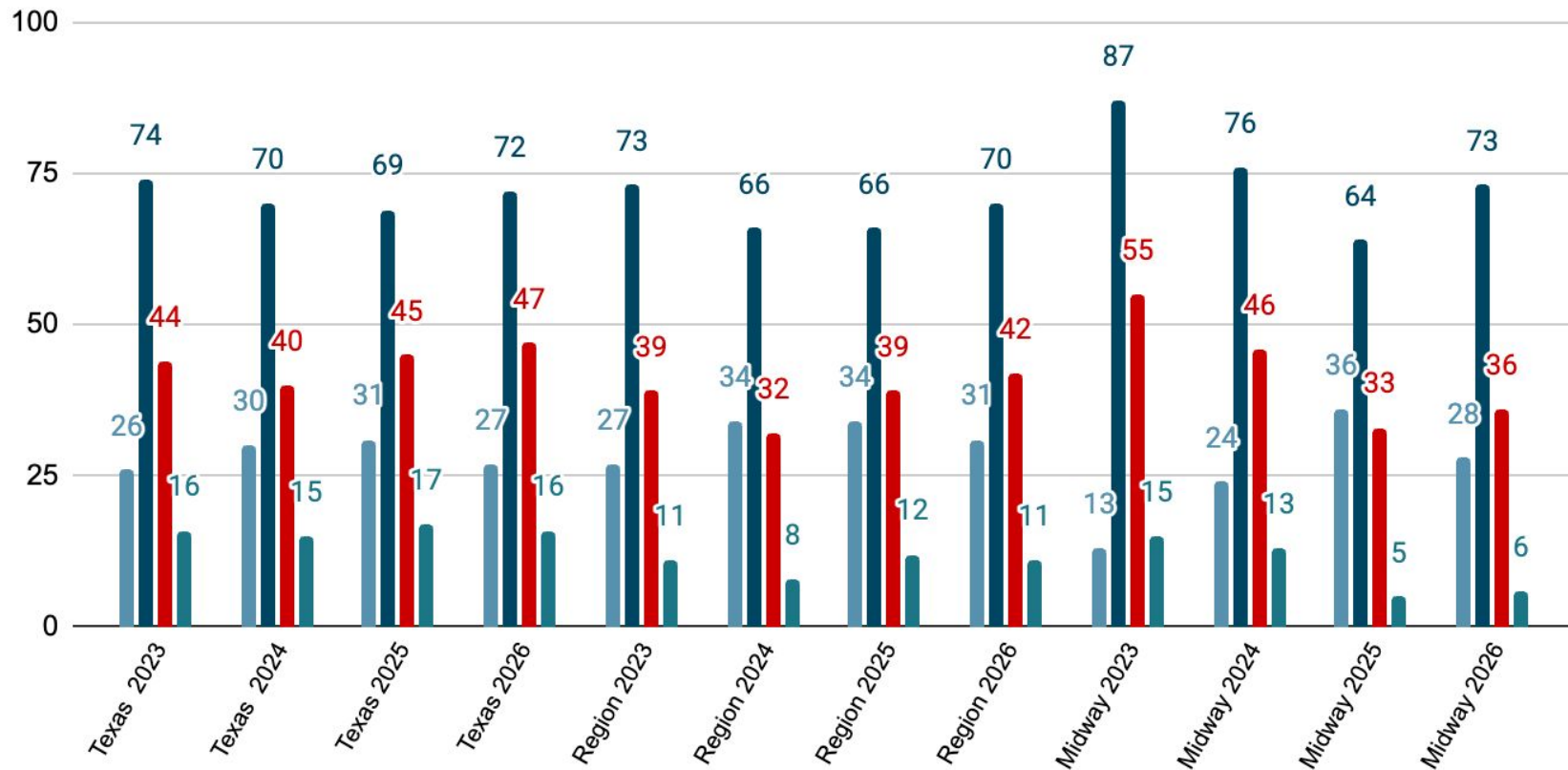

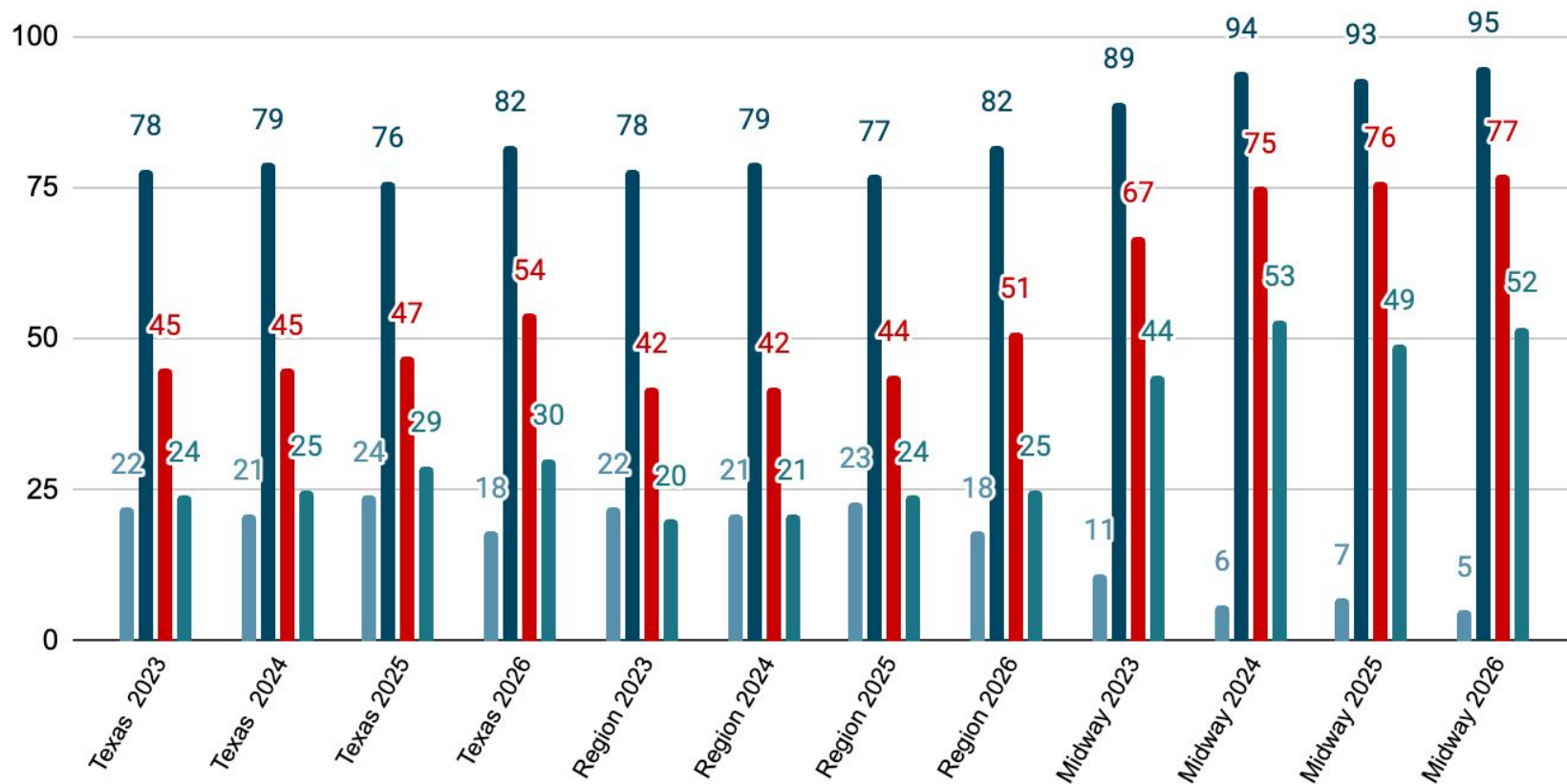

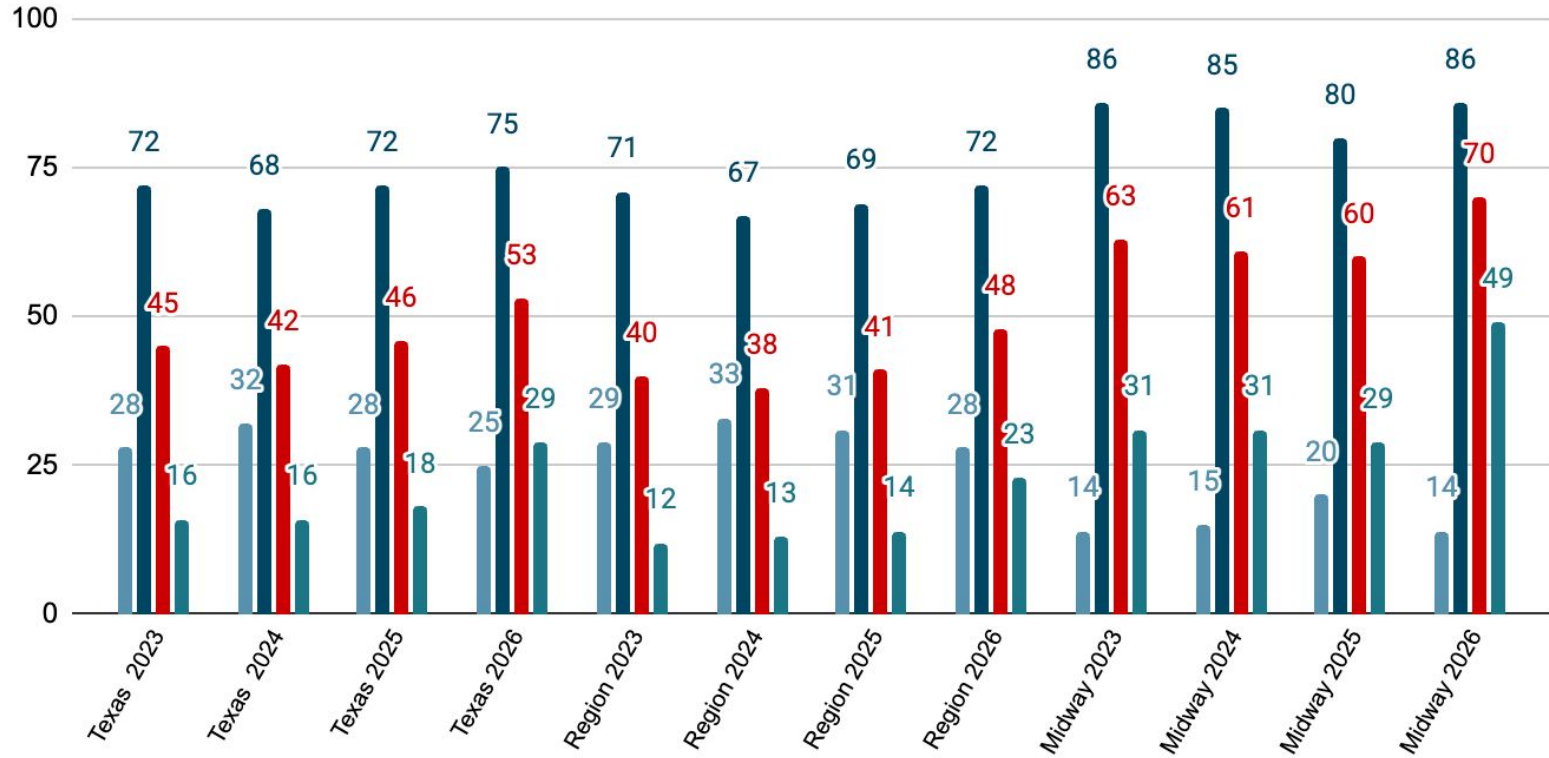

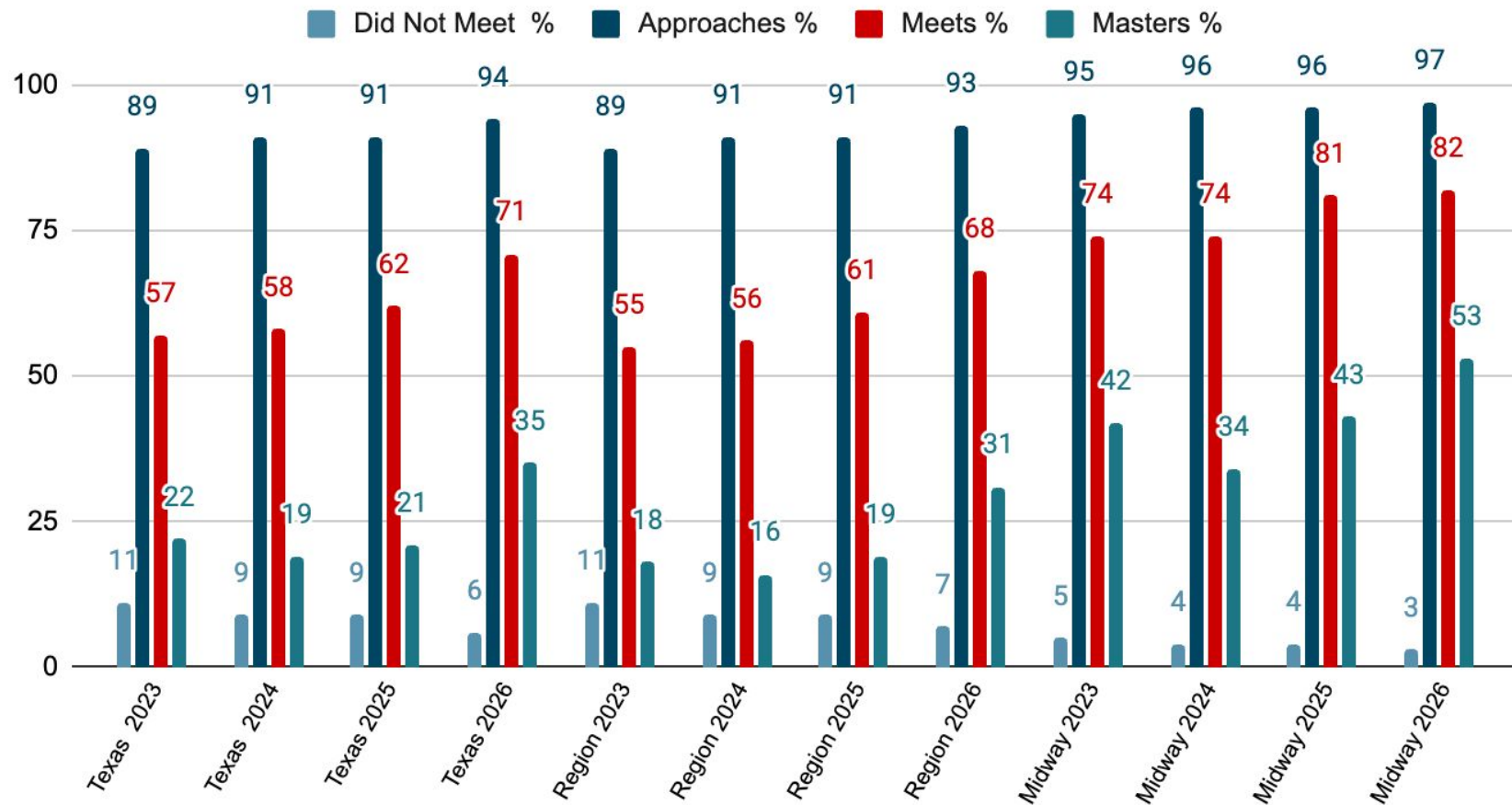

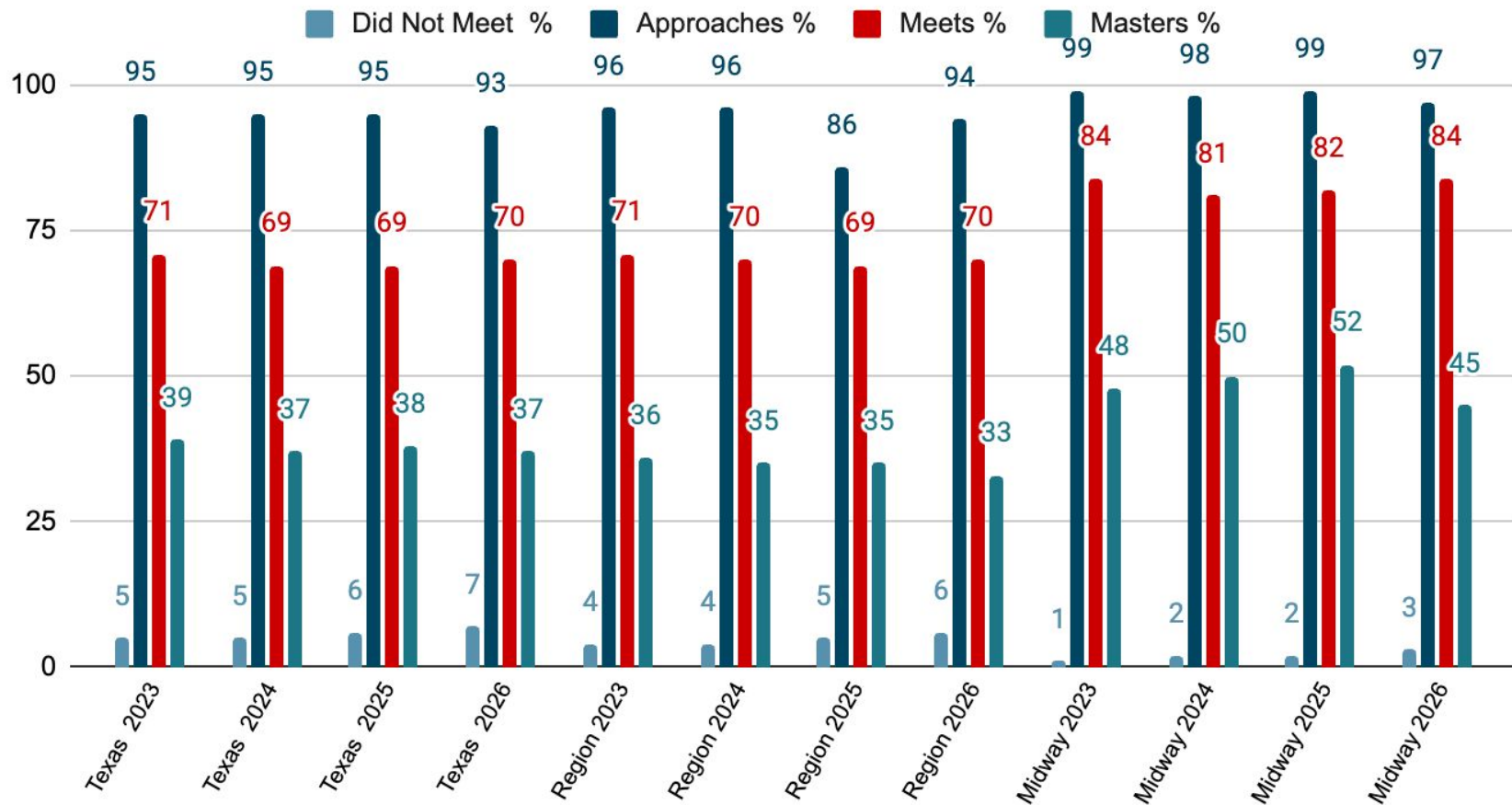

Overall Takeaways

- Significant Overall Growth in 12 of 18 Categories (Grade/Subject)
- Growth in Masters Performance in 13 of 18 Categories (Grade/Subject)
- Midway outperforms the State and Region in all grades and subjects, with one exception, 8th grade math in Meets and Masters. (We enroll more 8th students in Algebra 1 than most districts)
- 3rd & 5th Grade Math need specific support (Curriculum)
- Middle Grades Math and Social Studies continue to be a focus (Curriculum)
