Subject: Approval of Membership in the Lehigh University School Study Council (LUSSC)

Recommended Board Action

The annual membership fee provides five participants access to each of the seven professional learning sessions offered throughout the year.

Background Information

The Lehigh University School Study Council (LUSSC) is a consortium of school districts, schools, charter schools, and intermediate units dedicated to advancing educational leadership through high-quality professional learning opportunities. Membership provides access to programs focused on issues that superintendents and central office administrators address regularly and features nationally and regionally recognized educational leaders presenting on current topics impacting public education.

Participation will support the Central Bucks School District's commitment to continuous improvement, leadership development, and informed decision-making while advancing the goals of Vision 2030 through exposure to current research, innovative practices, and emerging educational trends.
