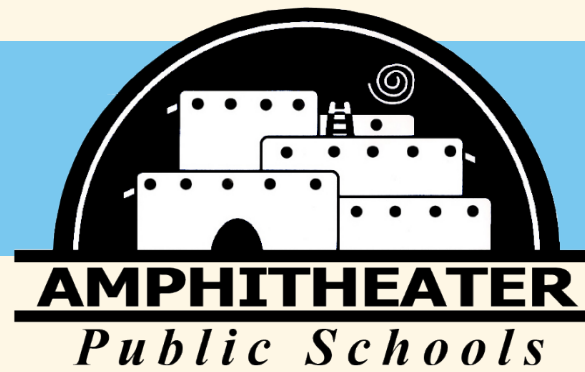

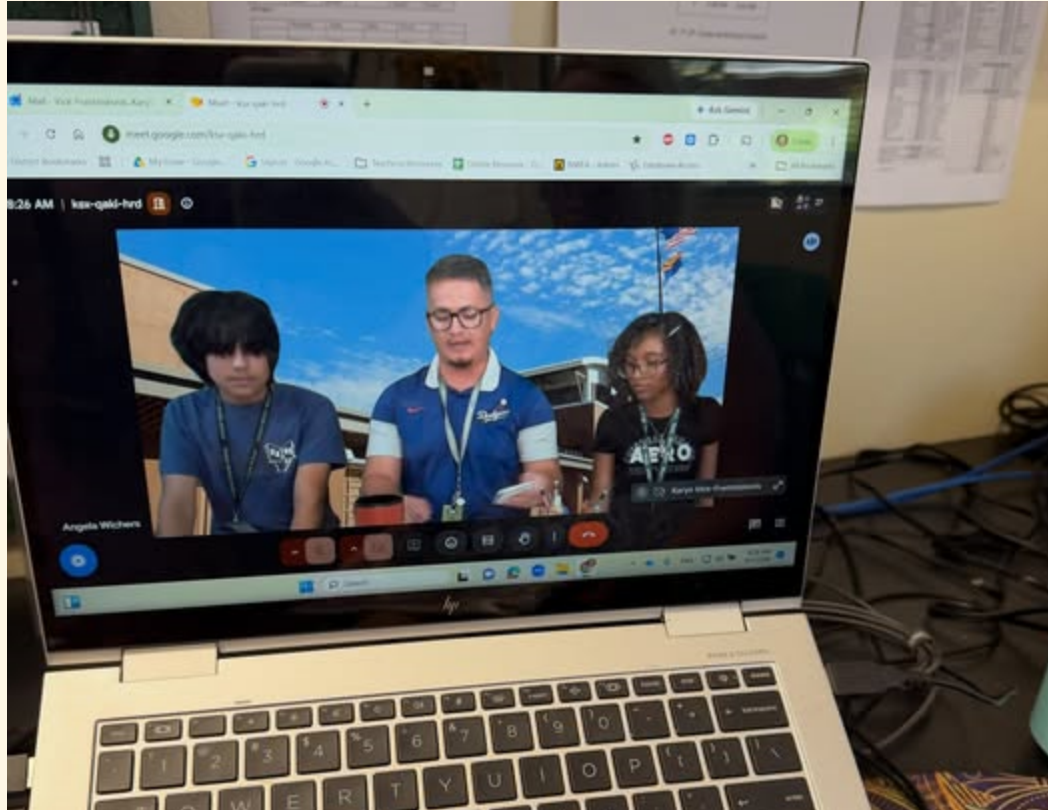
Scholarship
