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Cell Phone Information

In July 2025, Governor Tina Kotek released Executive Order No. 25-09 which requires that all Oregon school districts have a policy in place that restricts the use of personal electronic devices from the start of regular instructional hours to the end of regular instructional hours.

Each student will be assigned a Yondr pouch—a secure, lockable case for storing personal devices. Students are responsible for bringing their pouch to and from school each day and keeping it in good condition.

- **Upon arrival:** Students power off their phone, AirPods, and smartwatch (or switch to airplane mode), place all devices in the pouch, and lock it during their first class.
- **During the day:** Students keep the locked pouch in their backpack or locker.
- **At dismissal:** Students unlock pouches at designated stations to retrieve their devices.

This process is quick, simple, and will be supervised by staff as part of our daily routine.

Parking Lot Traffic Flow Change

The main entrance to the HS and in front of the gym will finally be 1-way this year. Please be mindful of the change when you return to school this fall.



Proposed Traffic Change

1. Change traffic flow past the south side of gymnasium to one way flow.
2. Provide a large standing stop sign at intersection.
3. Provide Bus Loading Zone on south side of gym.
4. All traffic from Middle School and East Parking will now exit out South onto NE Lake Blvd.
5. Parking in West Parking will exit onto HWY 101

NKN Immigration Enforcement Notification

Oregon law requires school districts to establish procedures for responding when federal immigration authorities enter school property for immigration enforcement purposes. As part of our commitment to keeping families informed and supporting a safe, welcoming school environment, Neah-Kah-Nie School District is providing parents and guardians the opportunity to opt in to receive notification if federal immigration enforcement authorities are confirmed to be on their child's school campus for an immigration enforcement purpose.

By completing **this** form, you are asking the District to notify you if such an event occurs involving the campus your child attends. Notifications will only be sent via ParentSquare, so please ensure you enroll in ParentSquare and select your notification settings within ParentSquare.

Important: This form is only for establishing your notification preference and current contact information. The District will not ask for or collect your child's or family's immigration or citizenship status through this form.
