Cardiac Emergency Response Planning (CERP)

- Each building has staff that have been trained and certified in CPR and AEDs.

- CERP information is part of the update Policy 806 - Crisis Management Policy.

[Minnesota Statutes 2025, section 121A.241](#) requires that school districts have a Cardiac Emergency Response Plan in place starting in the 2026-27 school year, which serves as an addendum to the crisis/emergency management plan. When adopted, the CERP becomes an addendum to the Crisis Management Policy and should be included in a building-level crisis management plan under the crisis-specific procedures section.
