Action	Discuss and consider approval of the Second Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding with San Jacinto Community College and Crosby ISD.
Motion	I move to approve the Second Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding with San Jacinto Community College and Crosby ISD.
Administrative Recommendation	The Administration recommends approving the Second Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding with San Jacinto Community College and Crosby ISD.
Authority for this Action	EHDD(LOCAL) – Alternative Methods for Earning Credit: College Course Work/Dual Credit An eligible student may enroll in a partnership program with a Texas college or university in accordance with an agreement between the district and the college or university.
Goal/Objective Addressed	Goal 10: College or Career Readiness: Graduates of Crosby ISD will be prepared for success after high school by being college, career, and military ready.
Background	The purpose of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Crosby Independent School District and San Jacinto Community College District is to establish the responsibilities of both parties related to the delivery of dual credit courses. The MOU addresses course locations and scheduling, faculty responsibilities, financial responsibilities, curriculum and instruction, academic policies, student eligibility, and the awarding of college and high school credit. The proposed Second Amendment updates the existing MOU in two areas. First, it extends the term of the agreement through August 1, 2027. Either party may terminate the agreement, with or without cause, upon 180 days' written notice; however, students enrolled in dual credit courses at the time of termination will be permitted to complete those courses. Second, the amendment establishes annual compliance training requirements for ISD-credentialed dual credit faculty. Faculty who completes the required training by the deadline established by San

	Jacinto Community College District will receive \$200 in annual compensation paid directly by the College. All other terms and conditions of the existing MOU remain in full force and effect.
Staffing Implications	Course instruction will be provided by existing Crosby ISD staff and/or San Jacinto Community College professors.
Budget Information	There are no additional direct budget implications to Crosby ISD associated with the approval of this amendment. San Jacinto Community College District will provide the \$200 annual compensation directly to eligible ISD-credentialed dual credit faculty upon completion of required compliance training. Existing costs associated with the district's dual credit program will continue to be managed within the approved budget.
Impact of this Action	Approval of this action will allow Crosby ISD to continue its dual credit partnership with San Jacinto Community College District through August 1, 2027. The agreement provides eligible students continued access to college-level coursework while earning both high school and college credit. The amendment also supports program quality and compliance by establishing annual training requirements for ISD-credentialed dual credit faculty.
