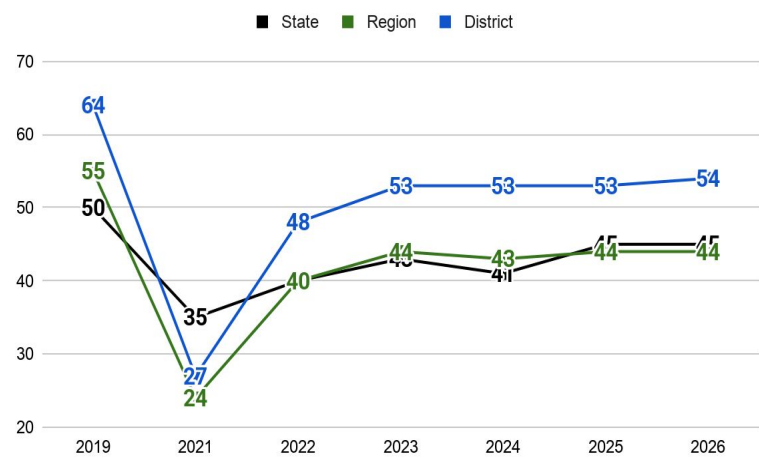


Overall Math - Grades 3-8 and Algebra I

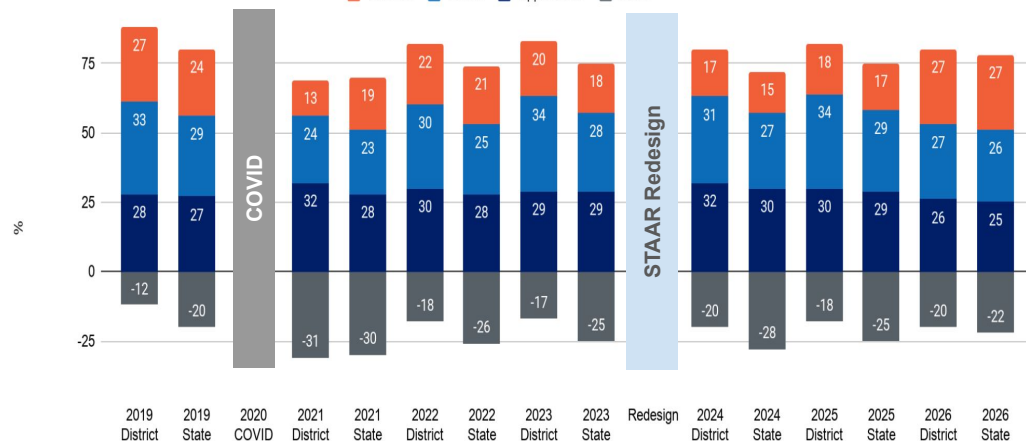

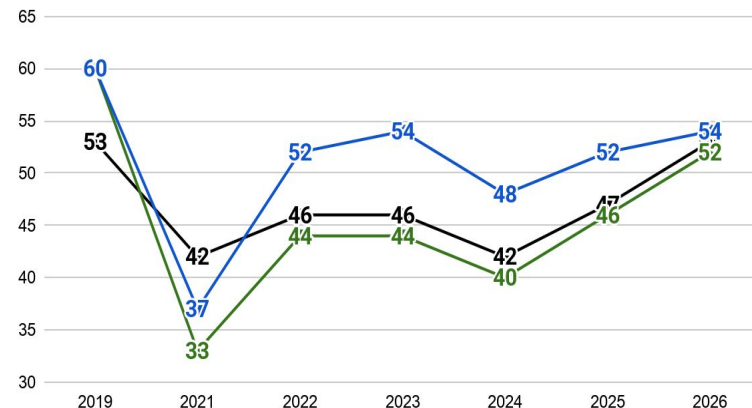

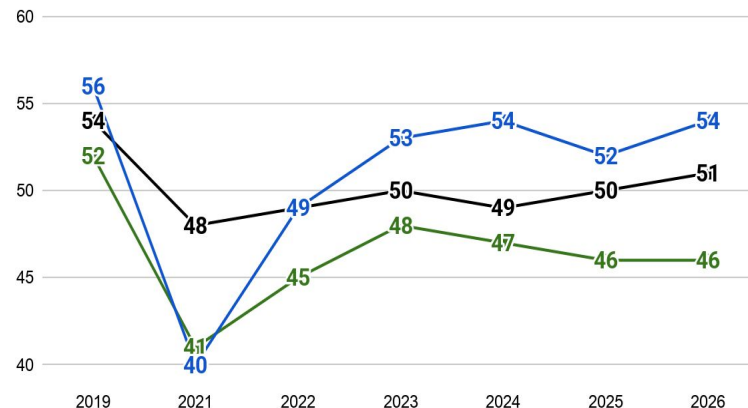
