Goals

Summative Evaluation: Measured by % of implementation of walk throughs; increased % of attendance rate for students and teachers; increased student performance on CBAs and TAKS; decrease in failure rates for each reporting period.

Performance Objective 2: If 100% of PHIS teachers are trained and utilize the best practice teaching strategies of collaboration and inquiry-based learning, and students collaborate and engage in inquiry-based learning 50% of the time, then the students' critical thinking and achievement will increase in all content areas.

Summative Evaluation: Increased % of teachers using powerful instructional strategies as noted in Schoolview data; increased % of lessons using inquiry-based learning; increased student performance on CBAs and TAKS test; increased % of students obtaining Commended rating on TAKS; obtain a rating of Exemplary from TEA

Performance Objective 3: If 100% of PHIS teachers use the district's assurance words and are trained in and implement Marzano's Building Academic Vocabulary strategies 100% of the time, then students will increase academic capacity.

Summative Evaluation: as measured by % of implementation on walk-through data; increased student achievement on CBAs and TAKS scores; decreased failure rates for each reporting period.
