Trends

- EL population has declined
- Recent Arriver / Newcomer population has declined
- SLIFE population has increased: students who enter school in US after 2nd grade
- overrepresented in SPED
- underrepresented in TAG
- elementary students more likely to be on track to EL proficiency
- low percentage meeting on high stakes tests
- lower college participation
- former ELs almost on track with never ELs
