

Consider Approval of Class Size Waivers
October 22, 2013

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval to apply for a maximum class size exemption waiver from the Texas Education Agency as required by Texas Education Code (TEA) 25.112 for Kindergarten through fourth grade for the following schools: Borman and Houston (these campuses are in addition to those previously considered on August 27, 2013).
