Background Information:

- The 2019 legislative session, House Bill 3 required school boards to adopt goals in two key areas for both the district and appropriate campuses:
 - Early childhood literacy and mathematics proficiency
 - College, career, and military readiness (CCMR)
- Early childhood literacy and mathematics goals must be aligned to third-grade STAAR meets grade-level performance.
- College, career, and military readiness goals must be aligned to graduates who meet readiness requirements.
- Each goal must include annual targets for all applicable student groups under the closing the gaps domain of accountability.
- Strategies and additional progress measures will be incorporated into the district and campus improvement plans.
- Our prior goals were set through the end of 2026; student performance from the 2026 school year now serves as the new baseline.

Administrative Considerations:

- District early childhood literacy and mathematics proficiency goals are recommended as follows:
 - **Note: 60% is considered an A for state accountability.**
 - *Proposed Literacy Goal:* The percent of 3rd grade students that score Meets Grade Level or above on STAAR Reading will increase to A-rated performance from 54% to

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60% by June 2031.

- *Proposed Numeracy Goal:* The percent of 3rd grade students that score Meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase to A-rated performance from 52% to 60% by June 2031.
- District College, career, and military readiness (CCMR) goals are recommended as follows:
 - ***Note: 88% is considered an A for state accountability at traditional High Schools & 60% at Alternative Education High Schools.***
 - *Proposed Goal:* The percentage of graduates that meet the criteria for CCMR will increase from 53% in 2026 to 85% by August 2031. (All A-Rated High Schools)
- Campus goals will be presented at the board meeting that are aligned with the district goals, along with appropriate student group targets at the campus and district level.
- Student group targets are included in the board book. Plans will be incorporated into the district and campus improvement plans.
- It is the administration's recommendation that the Board of Trustees approve the Early Childhood and College, Career, & Military Readiness Student Outcome Goals as presented.
