Fall Sports (Cross Country / Volleyball / Football)

Our athletic teams have been very competitive. Listed below are the records for each team. Our student athletes are held to a high standard and are entering into the second week of eligibility requirements this week.

- **Football** - Our football teams have had two/three games so far. We hosted Emmett Middle School. This was an added game to the SRV schedule.
 - 7th Grade - 3-0
 - 8th Grade - 2-0
- **Volleyball** - Our volleyball teams have had four/five games to date, Ontario, Wieser and Fruitland.
 - 7th Grade Volleyball - A Team 3-2 / B Team 2-3
 - 8th Grade Volleyball - A Team 3-1 / B Team 3-1
 - Both 7th & 8th A Teams competed in an opening Jamboree Tournament in Adrian, Oregon.
 - HMS teams finished 2nd and 3rd respectively.
