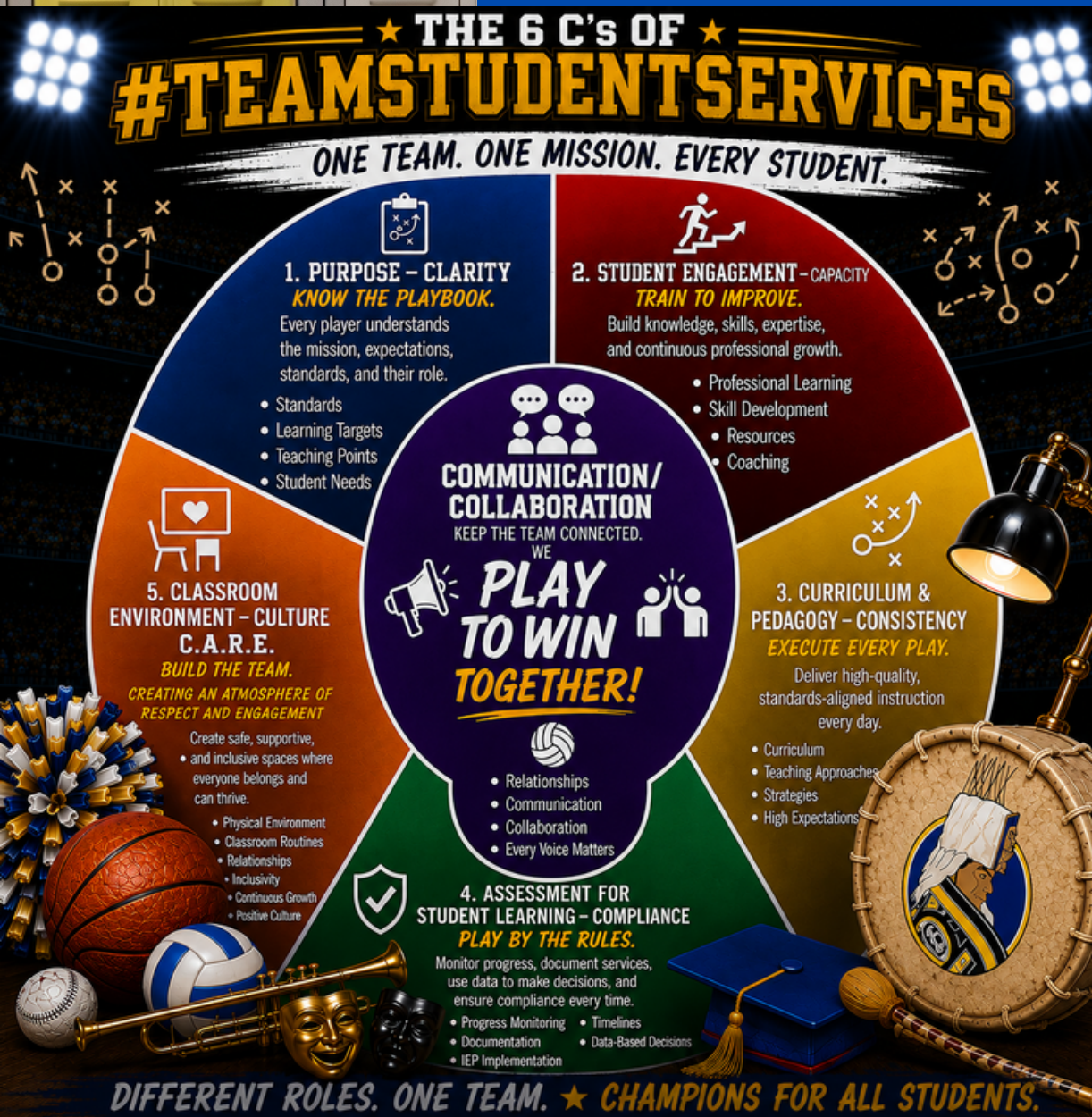

In August, our active caseload stands at 150 students, with 25 IEPs completed and 30 ESER evaluations conducted. We're proud to report a compliance rate of 95%, with service delivery at 90%. Additionally, we have made 40 parent/family contacts this month, strengthening our collaboration with families and ensuring their involvement in the educational process.

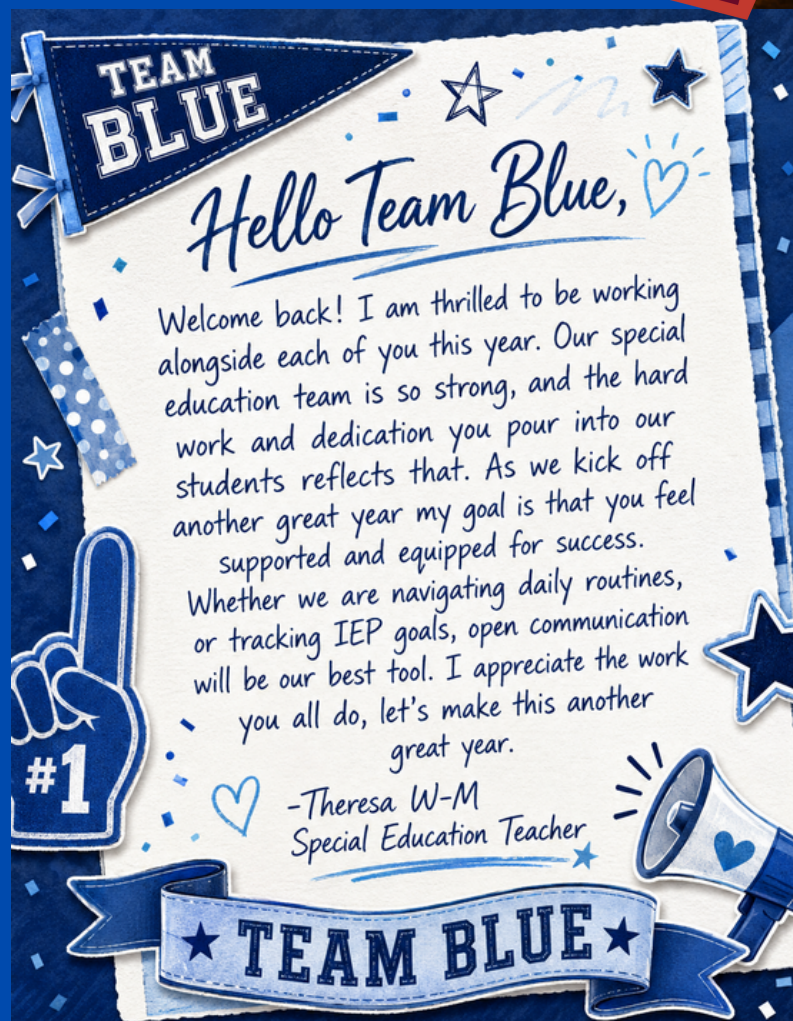
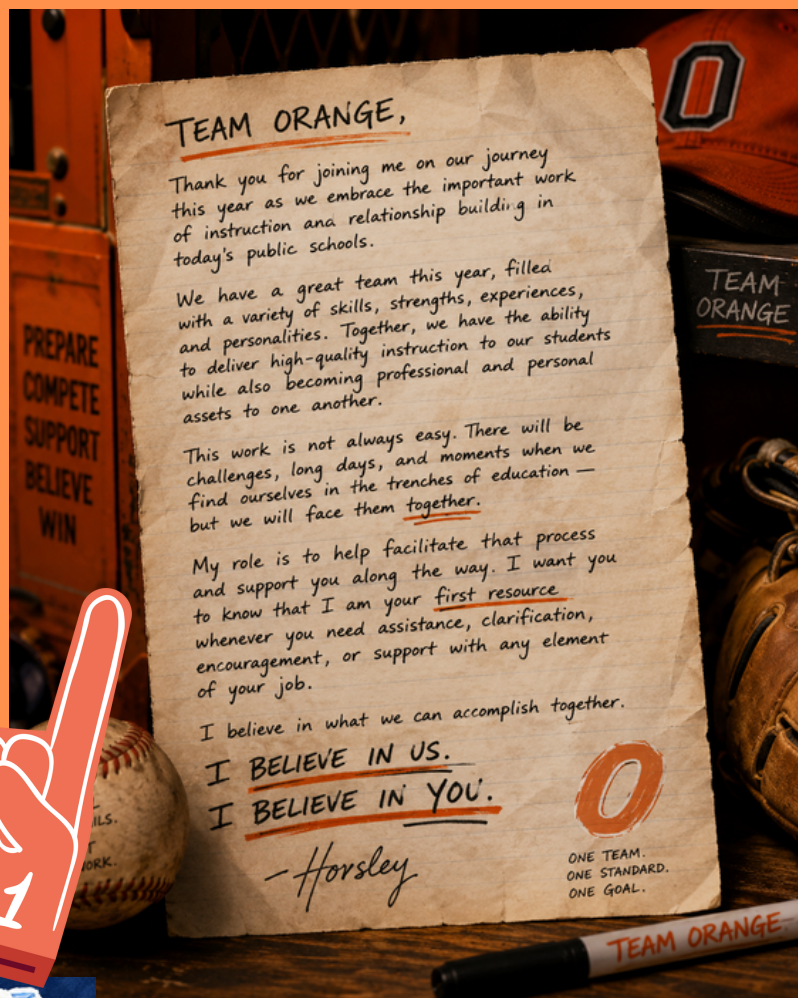

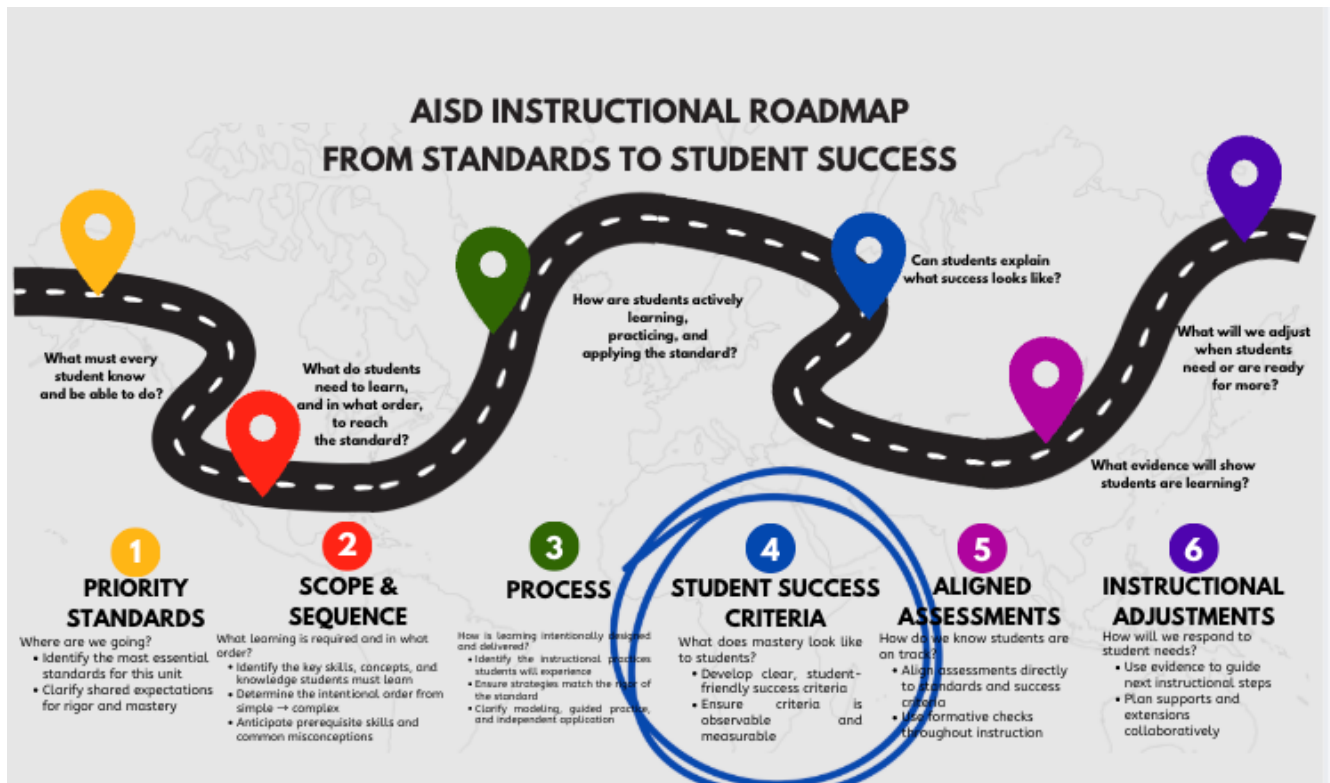
