Rationale:

By Board policy (6:190), "extracurricular or co-curricular activities are school-sponsored programs for which some or all of the activities are outside the instructional day". Extracurricular activity is an activity that is not part of the curriculum, is not graded, does not offer credit, and does not take place during classroom time; it includes competitive interscholastic activities and clubs.

The Superintendent must approve an activity in order for it to be considered a District-sponsored extracurricular or cocurricular activity, using the following criteria:

1. The activity will contribute to the leadership abilities, social well-being, self-realization, good citizenship, or general growth of student-participants.
2. Fees assessed students are reasonable and do not exceed the actual cost of operation.
3. The District has sufficient financial resources for the activity.
4. Requests from students.
5. The activity will be supervised by a school-approved sponsor.

Recommendation/Motion:

The administration recommends that the Board of Education approve the Coding Crew as an extracurricular AUGS hourly sponsorship as presented.
