



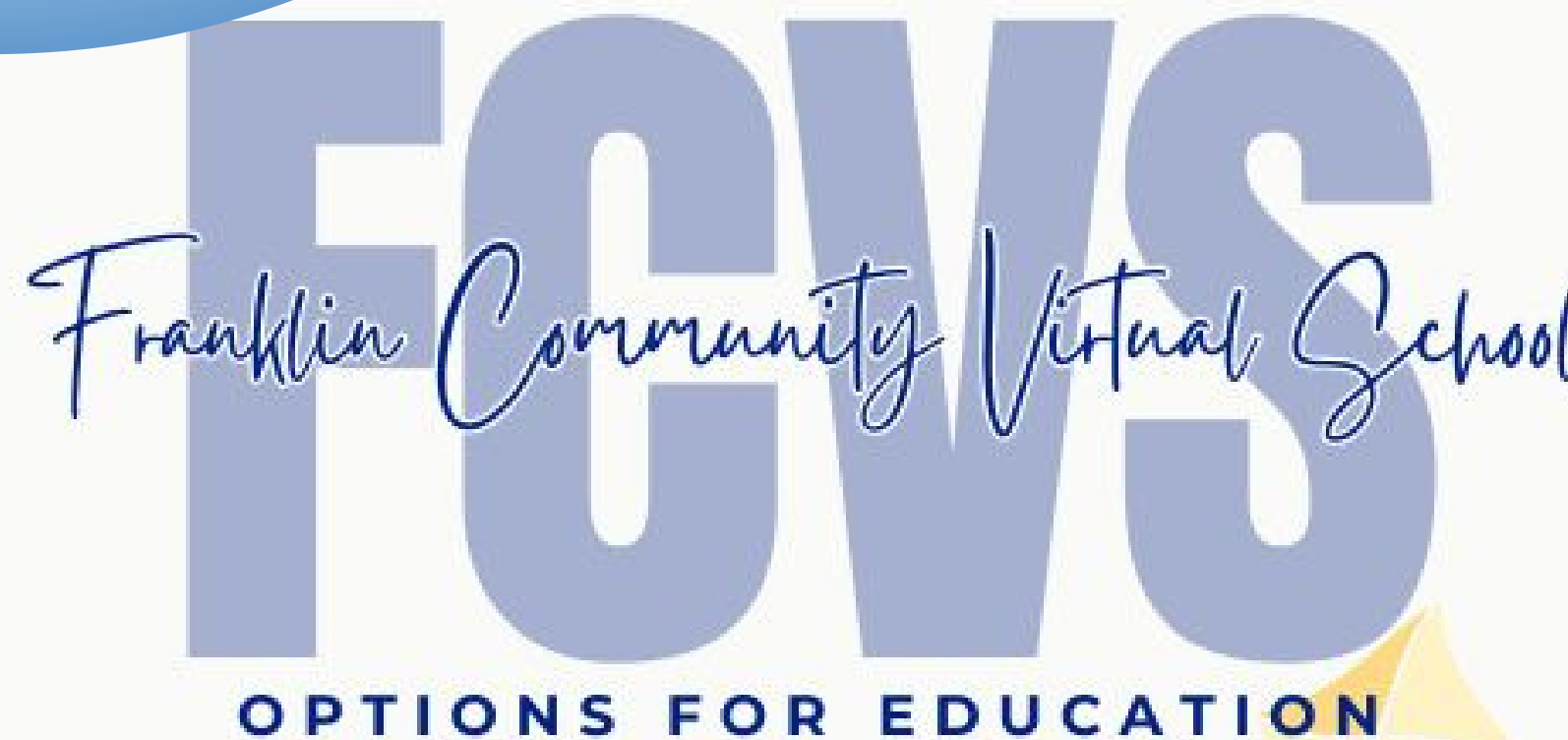

Where We Started

- Implementing a Plan-Do-Study-Adjust Model, FCVS launched in 2024 to provide families with a flexible, high-quality public education option.
- Indiana Online provides grades 6-12
- EdOptions Academy (a subsidiary of Edmentum) provides grades K-5
- Over the past two years, FCVS has continuously Studied and Adjusted:
 - Instructional quality
 - Student achievement
 - Attendance and engagement data
 - Intervention requirements and needs
 - Vendor communication and support
 - Ability to meet Indiana accountability requirements

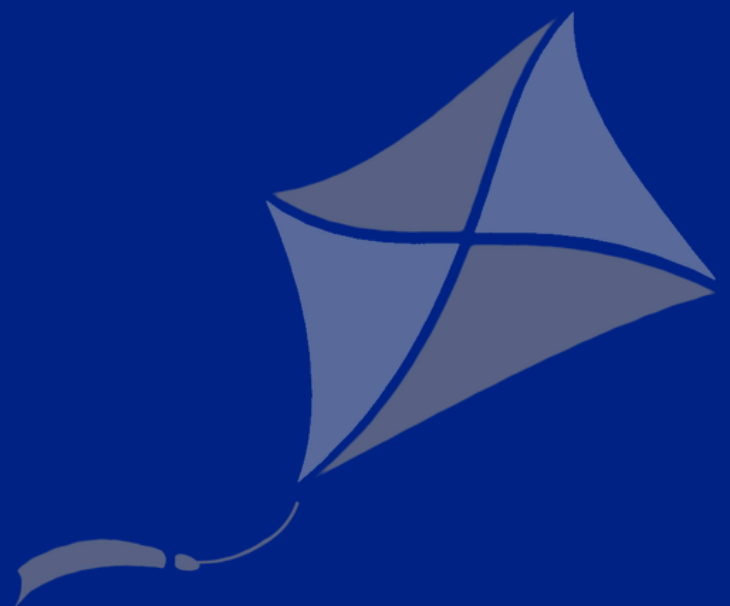

STUDY AND ADJUSTMENTS

FCVS identified concerns with EdOptions early in the partnership. The team decided to Study and Adjust for the next year (2025-2026):

- EdOptions was the only fiscally responsible option for synchronous, daily instruction K-5
- Indiana Online discontinued its 5th-grade offering, requiring FCVS to transition 5th-grade students to EdOptions.
- Changing providers immediately would have created additional disruption for students and families.
- FCVS repeatedly communicated concerns and sought improvements rather than making a premature decision.
- FCVS participated in **beginning-of-year, middle-of-year, and end-of-year conversations** and consistently communicated concerns regarding:
 - Support
 - Communication
 - Data access
 - Instructional quality
 - Student experience
- FCVS continued to believe the partnership could improve with additional communication and corrective action.

Persistent Concerns



Exact Path

FCVS did not gain meaningful access to students' Exact Path data until Fall 2026 - 2 years into the partnership.

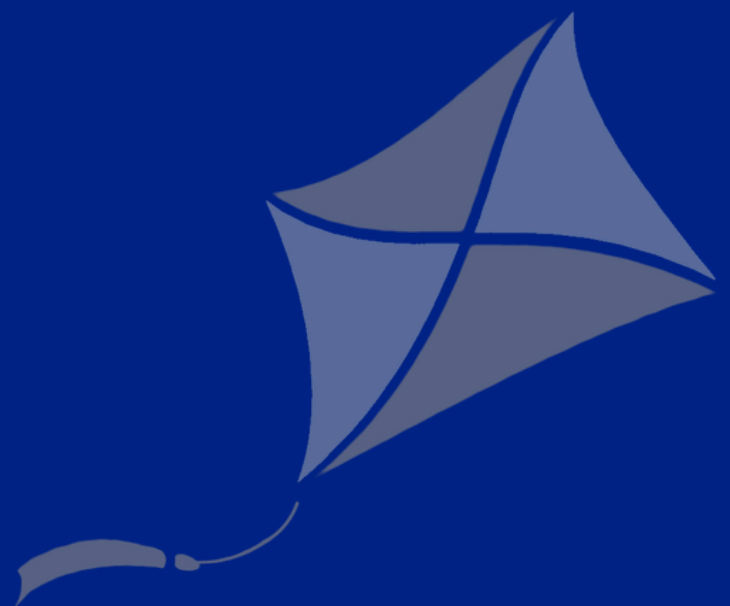
Attendance Data

Initially promised, this data lacked quality. This year, data has been unavailable since August 19th with minimal information on a fix date.

SOR Communication Frustrations

Lacking or insufficient responses to persistent issues. Repeating "we are working on it" with no updates or plan provided. Not communicating any of these changes or outages to us. Finding out second hand from frustrated parents.

Persistent Concerns



Parent Feedback

Frequent frustrations with system issues, lack of communication, repeated changes in schedules, etc.

Parent Communication

Teachers did not reach out to parents of students who were not attending or communicate concerns in any method other than email.

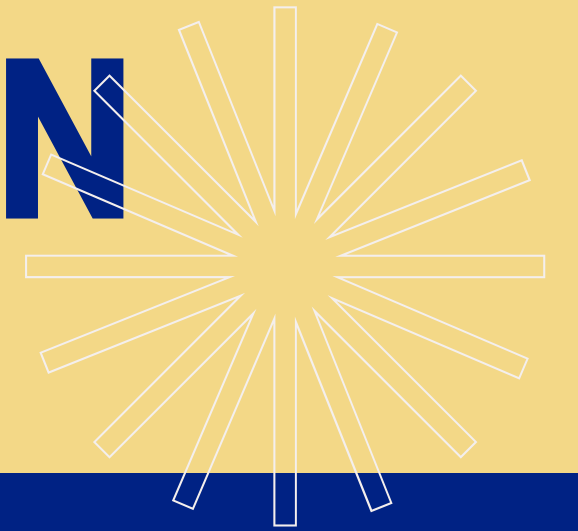
Tier 1 Instruction Issues

FCVS does not control Tier 1 instruction and students are consistently not passing state assessments.

Test Scores

Test/Date	24-25 (3&4)	25-26 (3,4,&5)
IREAD	100% (1 student tested)	33% (3 students tested)
ILEARN Math	37.5%	13.6%
ILEARN ELA	50%	16%

RECOMMENDATION



Considering these factors, we are recommending cancelation of the EdOptions/Edmentum Partnership.

- Eliminate current K-5 structure & most enrollments
- Continue options at K-5 level for medically necessitated situations

Timeline

- School Year Closure: End partnership in May
