

RESOLUTION 26-053- Approval of Re-Coding of Policy KNA-Cooperation with Private Enterprises

Background: With the adoption of required Board Policy KNA – Immigration Enforcement on MESD Property, MESD’s existing Policy KNA – Cooperation with Private Enterprises must be re-coded to avoid a duplicate policy code. After consultation with OSBA Policy Services, it was recommended that Cooperation with Private Enterprises be re-coded as Policy KNB. This update reflects the change in policy code; no substantive changes are being made to the existing policy language.

WHEREAS, the Multnomah Education Service District Board of Directors Policy Committee has reviewed and discussed Board Policy KNB Cooperation with Private Enterprises; and

WHEREAS, the Multnomah Education Service District Board of Directors Policy Committee recommends the Board adopt Board Policy KNB Cooperation with Private Enterprises;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Board Policy KNB Cooperation with Private Enterprises is approved as written or as further modified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if no further discussion is required, Board Policy -KNB Cooperation with Private Enterprises is approved as proposed and does not require a second reading.

Cooperation with Private Enterprises

Cooperation with private enterprise is encouraged when such cooperation works to improve the quality of public education at the same time it serves in the public interest.

MESD may contract with private enterprise clients for service delivery subject to state law and MESD and Local Contract Review Board policies and administrative regulations.

Services may be provided to private enterprise clients when such services: (1) are provided primarily to benefit the students and programs of MESD and/or the clients being served; (2) are provided on the basis of a written contract; (3) are fully self-supporting; (4) do not erode the ability of MESD to provide services to the component districts and (5) are appropriate for MESD to provide.

Private agencies may be enabled to participate in the regional services delivery system through contractual agreements.

MESD along with other ESDs, component districts or other public/private entities under contract with an ESD may provide services and facilities.
