District Goals:

Goal 1: By 2032, 95% of Manor ISD scholars will graduate prepared for college, career, and/or military services based upon their individual goals.

Goal 3: By 2032, provide transparent, consistent, and timely communication to all in our educational community, while meeting their diverse needs.

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Background Information:

Manor ISD is seeking to continue our contract with ImmSchools to strengthen instructional practices and family engagement in support of multilingual learners and their families.

ImmSchools will provide professional learning and resources to build staff capacity in meeting the linguistic and academic needs of multilingual learners. This work will include support with aligning the intended use of High-Quality Instructional Materials (HQIM) with teacher execution, with a focus on effective implementation and meaningful access to grade level instruction.

The partnership will also strengthen engagement with multilingual and immigrant families by addressing language barriers, increasing access to school and district information, and supporting families in understanding instructional programs, available resources, and opportunities to participate in their child's education.

Fiscal Implications:

We anticipate expenditures could reach about \$80,000, allowing room for additional services (if needed), utilizing the Federal Title III budget.

Administrative Recommendation:

Administration recommends approval of agreement with ImmSchools to provide professional learning, instructional support, and multilingual family engagement services for Manor ISD for the 2026-2027 school year.

Motion Language:

I move that the board approve the expenditure of over \$50,000 for the agreement with ImmSchools as submitted.
