Bilingual/ESL Summer School



- Bilingual/ESL summer school is offered to incoming EB students:
 - Kindergarten and 1st Grade
 - 120 hours of instruction are required in the summer
- Enrollment and Attendance:
 - Located at Science Hall ES
 - Incoming Kinder: 109 students - 2 ESL & 3 Bilingual Teachers
 - Incoming 1st grade: 61 students - 1 ESL & 2 Bilingual Teachers
 - Class size ratio is 18:1
- Instruction Highlights:
 - Reading Language Arts
 - Math
 - Academic language development & literacy in the content areas
- Pre and Post Assessment:
 - Results provided to parents through end of program report cards

Special Education Summer School

- Extended School Year (ESY) is required to ensure services are available to implement a student's Individualized Education Program (IEP) over the summer
 - Prevent regression & recoupment of skills
 - Enrollment and Attendance
 - Elementary: 31
 - Middle School: 3
 - High School: 5
 - Located at Science Hall ES throughout June
- Compensatory Services are required when services required in a student's IEP were not provided as written
 - Enrollment and Attendance
 - Elementary: 9
 - Located at Science Hall ES throughout June
- IEP Progress Reports
 - Data collected by teacher through out ESY and entered in Frontline Service Management System. Parents are sent an IEP progress report via email for the ESY reporting period.
