

Approval of the Annual Temporary Facility Report and Elimination Plan for Centennial Elementary School (2026–2027 School Year)

Purpose

To present the Board of Education with the administrative recommendation to approve the annual Temporary Facility Report and Elimination Plan for the relocatable modular classrooms at Centennial Elementary School through June 30, 2027, in compliance with Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) regulations and Part 180 of the Illinois Administrative Code.

Background and Information

Streator Elementary School District 44 utilizes one relocatable building consisting of four classrooms at Centennial Elementary School to house up to 50 students across Special Education Resource and EL Department programs.

In accordance with state requirements and the certified inspection conducted by BCA Architects, Ltd., the facility has been reviewed for health and life safety compliance, noting no areas of noncompliance. The long-term elimination plan looks toward future capital projects for permanent classroom space, with a target completion date of June 30, 2030, as permanent new construction remains economically unattainable at this time.

Key Provisions

- The temporary facility houses a maximum of 50 students across four modular classrooms (4,900 square feet) originally constructed in 2022.
- The facility inspection verified full compliance with health and life safety conditions with no listed deficiencies.
- The formal elimination plan targets permanent solutions by June 30, 2030.
- The request authorizes facility usage through June 30, 2027, pursuant to 23 Ill. Adm. Code 180.230.

Administrative Recommendation

The administration recommends that the Board of Education approve the annual Temporary Facility Report and Elimination Plan for Centennial Elementary School for the 2026–2027 school year and authorize the Board President and Superintendent to sign the required submittal documentation.
