❖ New School Year:

- With two weeks completed, we are off to a positive start. Our Open House night was a great success in all three schools and the hotdog supper was a fun way to feed our returning students and their families.
- Fall Activities and Sports are in full swing and our students are enjoying their experiences.
- Students and staff were ready for school and in great spirits on our first day. This has continued to help us have a great start.
- Our schools were ready for students, with the Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) project at the high school providing increased fresh air that is cooled for dehumidification. Thank you to the custodians, and rest of the staff who brought the buildings together to be ready for Open House and our first day of school.

❖ Permanent School Fund Constitutional Amendment:

- There will be a constitutional amendment on the ballot this November regarding Minnesota Public School Trust. If approved, this would change the amount that can be distributed to Public Schools, Charters and Tribal Schools. The fund has grown to more than 2.3 billion dollars, so increasing distributions of these funds will better serve public school students of our State. This amendment would not create a new fund, or raise taxes, but would allow more funds to be distributed to public schools in our state. Foley Public School's projected increase would be \$61,326.87, according to the data run on the MN School Board's Association website.
