Sewer Connection Variance Request

Chairperson Johnson opened the public hearing.

Matt Goss presented a request to permit a proposed body shop building to connect to the existing ejector pit and sewer lead serving the property. There are two buildings already tied into the existing line, the second building isn't in use and hasn't been used in about 15 years. Discussion included alternative connection options explored with Genesee County, future development potential, maintenance responsibilities, and documentation requirements. No public comments were received.

The public hearing was closed.

Motion by Mason, supported by Bryan, to approve the sewer connection for the Simms building, subject to Simms letter for construction and maintenance for sewer cost in the future, if there is any.

Minimum lot size and Setback Variance Request

Pat Parker presented a request for variances in industrial parcel size and setback requirements for a sheet metal apprenticeship and training facility.

Representatives of this corporation outlined the program, operations, traffic expectations, and educational benefits. The Board discussed compatibility with surrounding properties and the limited intensity of the proposed use. No public comments were received.
