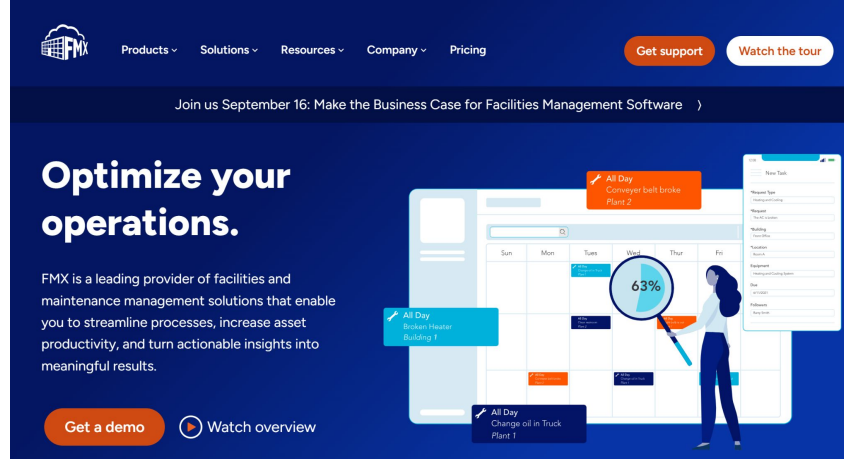
We are grateful for the support of the community and the district for this much needed upgrade!

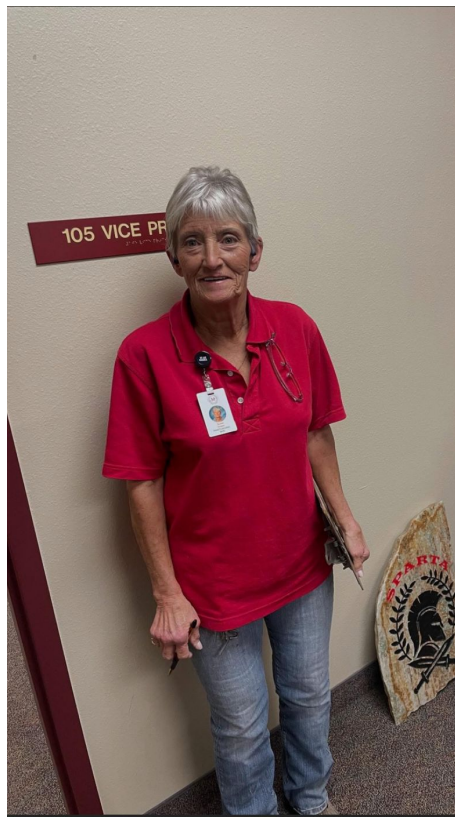
Building Custodian Leads will use the software to complete and track essential tasks.
