- The Aquatic Center has been closed down for the season. We have run a camera down the lines that are having issues and found 3 lines that have been frozen and broke the pvc piping. We have been working with the people who designed the facility to understand what went wrong and no one can find the answer. I have called Horizon Commercial Pool to come give us a quote and suggestion on how they think we can fix it and they will get back to me next week.
- The fall hydrant flushing has taken place and I did go listen to hydrants in the Maplebrook subdivision to listen for leaks and so far, so good.
- With all of the Summer help done for the season, full time employees are filling in with the mowing and park duties.
- Signs have been ordered for the south parking lot at the Civic Center/ Mrotek parking lot. We will install them upon arrival.
- Batteries were ordered and installed on the South Speed Limit Radar Sign. We have ordered batteries for the North one and will be installed when they come in. They make these batteries so it takes a while for them to arrive.
- I have received the plans back for the Rolling Ridge Restroom/Shelter Facility. I will be sending them out for bidding next week.
- Some tree work from high winds has been taken care of.
- We have mowed outlots and the area that Dairyland has purchased from us to keep the weeds down.
- We have been working with the Chamber for setting things up for their fall festival/ Oktoberfest.

I won't bore you with all of the daily routine things but keeping up with mowing without the summer help eats up quite a bit of time.
