806.1PR Cardiac Emergency Response Plan (CERP)

- Committee Discussion: Minnesota Statutes 2025, section 121A.241, established a new requirement for school districts to develop a Cardiac Emergency Response Plan (CERP). The statute requires the school board to review the CERP annually; therefore, it will be incorporated into the district's annual review of Policy 806. Because the CERP is an administrative procedure, it may be adopted in a single reading.
