WHEREAS, Fisher County Hospital District is committed to maintaining Fisher County Hospital as designated *Level IV* trauma center; AND,

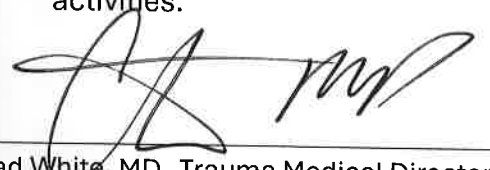
WHEREAS, Fisher County Hospital District trauma plan was approved by the State of Texas in 1995; AND,

WHEREAS, through its *Level IV* services, Fisher County Hospital District provides trauma care and professional trauma education and training; AND,

WHEREAS, Fisher County Hospital District will provide organizational oversight of the system, guidelines for improvement of the trauma system, and structure for implementations are developed after careful systematic evaluations; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Fisher County Hospital District approves the trauma care plan and specifically supports the following actions:

- 1) Maintain a multi-disciplinary, multi-departmental trauma system committee,
- 2) Maintain standardized trauma system data collection and analysis,
- 3) Evaluate policies to ensure comprehensive care of trauma patients,
- 4) Maintain relationship of regional transfer system (Big Country RAC TSA-D) to maximize the use of trauma research, education, prevention, and patient care activities.
