Background Information

208 DEVELOPMENT, ADOPTION, AND IMPLEMENTATION OF POLICIES

Background:

School districts are encouraged to have this policy. The policy presented is based on the Minnesota School Boards Association model policy and differs as follows:

Part IV, A and B: one meeting versus two meetings

Part IV, D: Optional provision added. Staff is directed to revise policy with minor, technical changes without the need to follow part A and B. Staff will notify the school board, by information report, when this process is followed.

Part V, A does not include the following: These guidelines and directives, including employee and student handbooks, shall be subject to annual review and approval by the school board.

Part V, B: Policies can be accessed by district website and will not be placed in the office of each school attendance center.

The policy has been reviewed by administration and the policy committee and approval is recommended.
