Existing Structure	Primary Purpose	How It Could Contribute to the Developing System
Snapshot Walks	Document use of the MSD Instructional Model.	Provide district and school-level implementation evidence, identify patterns in instructional practice, and inform principals' next steps for teacher professional learning.
Instructional Walks	Examine instructional practices and learning environments, and calibrate feedback for teachers.	Provide timely, meaningful, and actionable feedback to support teachers' practice.
Principal Observations	Provide individual teacher feedback and supervision.	Provide deeper evidence of implementation and instructional practice.
Professional Learning	Build educator knowledge and instructional capacity.	Establish the intended practice/change that the monitoring process is looking for.
Student Evidence (classroom work & assessments)	Examine evidence of student learning.	Provide a complementary source of evidence when determining potential impact.
