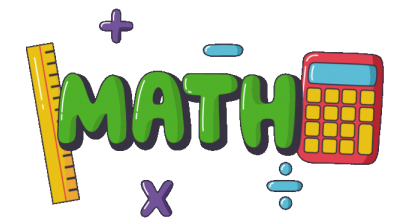


Math Club 1st/2nd Grade
