**CDL Class:** Four students have enrolled to get their CDL class done through MState.

#### **AA Degree:**

We have moved forward with aligning our classes with an AA degree from Alex Technical College. I have included a plan that shows how we can support students with the classes we offer and classes through online learning. We will still work with SMSU for our in person college classes. I will be setting up a parent meeting in February to give information to all parents who are interested in having their student earn an AA degree. Mrs. DeLorenzo and I will work together to support students as they work through this during their high school career.

An AA degree is a total of 60 credits. If a student were to take all 60 college credits through the OCHS program, it would be approximately \$7,800.

#### **Registration:**

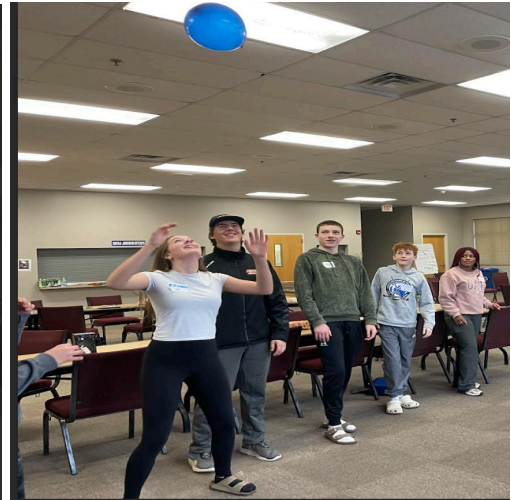
We will begin registration in February for all students 6-11. We have a new class that will be offered for our 9-12 girls called Women in Strength Training.
