- (3) reports in two categories – instructional or operational; and
- (4) all DERs listed on the Board’s Master Calendar of Board Meetings in June each year.

DER Template - Sections

- Description – general function, structure, staffing and students served
- Quality Effectiveness Indicators – effectiveness, efficiency, compliant, safe, and continual improvement
- Evidence of Core Beliefs – opportunity to brag

DERs (2 month process)

- 2 months prior to report – e mail sent to board asking for questions to be answered in DER
- 1 month prior to report – e mail sent to the Board with the completed DER
- Board meeting – Power Point Presentation reviewing DERs
- Immediately following the Board meeting – DERs are posted on the BISD web page
