November 19, 2024 - Board approves process

January 2025-May 2025 - Track enrollment numbers, determine target numbers for schools involved in the study.

May 2025 – Meet with the Community Council & Staff at the schools

June 2025 – Using input from school meetings and enrollment data draw preliminary boundary proposal

July 15, 2025 – Present initial proposal to the Board – share next steps
