The Principals were in attendance. Miss McRoberts highlighted the upcoming open house on Thursday, August 24th at 6:30 p.m. She congratulated Eric Schafer on his State Science fair win. Eric is now eligible to go to the National Science Fair in Indianapolis. The High School's "Good Deeds Club" and the local AAMP group went to each School and wrote positive messages in chalk on the sidewalks before the first day of school.
