

Cameron High School Board Report - July 28, 2014

Building Updates - Renovation and remodeling continue to be done at the high school and things are taking shape. Turf has been put on the football field.

Computer Insurance Change - The cost for the optional insurance plan will be \$50 for the upcoming school year. Students with the insurance plan will be able to replace their charger one time if the charger becomes defective.

School Orientation/Registration - Tuesday, September 2nd will be our Freshmen Orientation. There are a number of sessions planned to help students get orientated to the building, procedures, etc. We will also have clubs and activities available for students to learn about and sign up for. Freshmen and New Student orientation to the laptop computers will be held on August 18th and 19th.

Returning students will start school on Wednesday, September 3rd. Students will be able to get their computers, schedules, pay lunch money, etc from August 18th through the 22nd.
