## **Athletics Updates**

### Tennis

• The Tennis team has a team record of 3-14 on the season as they will be finishing up their regular season next week. Seven of their matches have been decided by one result otherwise their overall record could be very different. Tori Oehrlein is currently ranked 6th in the latest Class A Individual Ranking and is 16-1 overall on the season at #1 Singles. At #2 Singles Emma Silgen is 10-7 and Nellie Fitzpatrick is 11-6 at #3 Singles.

## Volleyball

 Ranger Volleyball has had a great start to the season with a 10-2 overall record. They took 3rd at the 39th Annual Neprud Tournament that hosted 16 teams here at C-I last weekend. They are undefeated in both Section & Conference play so far and are looking forward to Tuesday September 23rd as they will host #4 AA Ranked Rush City to the Galovich Gym.

### **Football**

Coach Syrstad's team is off to a 1-2 record with both losses being by a combined 8 points. After traveling to
Mesabi East last Friday they look ahead to Homecoming this coming Friday, September 26th vs
Hinckley-Finlayson. Keyon Wesner leads the team with 435 yards passing and 5 TD passes and Jeremy Henson
has 207 yards receiving along with 2 TD catches. Kaleb Billman leads all defenders with 42 total tackles and 2
sacks to go along with his 154 yards rushing on the offensive side.

• The Cross Country team has had four meets so far this season. Sophia Hanson & Peter Bartels have been the top finishers at each race this year with Sophia's highest finish being 5th place and Peter placing 4th both at Pine River. Both teams are very young and gaining experience with every race as Coach Perpich's team looks to peak when postseason racing begins.
