1. Provide a DETAILED RATIONALE explaining how the waiver will enhance student learning opportunities, promote innovation, or increase equitable access to effective teachers. Include information about the problem or obstacle; if any, the waiver will help the district overcome.

The member school districts of the Northeast Arkansas Education Service Cooperative are collectively and separately requesting a waiver from A.C.A. 6-10-106, which establishes the first allowable day of class as the Monday of the week that contains August 19. For the 2024-2025 school year, it will be Monday, August 19, 2024.

We respectfully request a waiver to allow the Jackson County School District to set their start date "no earlier" than August 12 for each of the next five school years.

The advantages of the early start option include the following:

- 1. It gives us a greater chance of having more instructional time before state testing, even in years when we miss a significant number of days due to inclement weather.
- 2. It allows us to begin in mid-August when students and staff are eager to return to the new year and complete the year by the end of May before many of the summer activities begin in early June.
- 3. It provides a greater balance between the number of days in the first and second semesters of the school year.

2. Provide a detailed explanation of how the services being waived will be provided for students.

The requested waiver will not impact the calendar length chosen by the Jackson County School District. It will only provide the flexibility to begin the school year earlier, providing the above advantages to students, staff, and parents. The services provided to our students will be the same as those supplied without waiver approval regarding days and/or hours of instruction.

3.	Provide a detailed explanation of how the district will monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the
	waiver.

The district will monitor the following items: 1) # of instructional days or hours gained in advance of state testing by starting earlier, 2) student and staff attendance on those dates, and 3) state test results to try and determine what correlation exists between achievement results and instruction time before testing.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF Jackson County School District AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT TO REQUEST A WAIVER

WHEREAS, the Jackson County School District Board of Directors is committed to providing a high-quality education to all students within the district;

WHEREAS, certain circumstances or regulations may require the district to seek waivers to better address the unique needs or challenges faced by the district;

WHEREAS, Jackson County School District is requesting a school start date waiver from A.C.A. 6-10-106 to set their start date "no earlier" than August 12 for each of the next five school years.

WHEREAS, the advantages of the early start option include: giving the school a greater chance of having more instructional time before state testing; allowing students and staff to begin in mid-August when they are eager to return to the new year; completion of the year by the end of May before early June summer activities begin; providing a greater balance between the number of days in the first and second semesters of the school year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Jackson County School District hereby authorizes the district administration to formally request a waiver from A.C.A. 6-10-106 to set their start date "no earlier" than August 12 for each of the next five school years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent or designee is authorized to take all necessary steps and actions to submit the waiver request, including providing any additional information or documentation required by the relevant authorities;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors expresses its support for the waiver request and acknowledges the importance of flexibility in addressing the unique needs and circumstances of the district.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.




