

During Christmas Break power outages, the school suffered a catastrophic water failure do to the boilers not resetting that caused the school to freeze up. The Fire Sprinklers, fire pump, Science lab eye wash station, and 3 classroom faucets froze and bursted. I was out of town in Anchorage dealing with Health issues when this happened.

Fuel Report, we are still using more than twice the amount of fuel with the school. The schools boilers, air handlers, and baseboard controllers are set to manual run. Causing the boilers to run 24/7. Teacher housing apartments by the school used approximately 1500 gallons in one month, a couple units thermostats were set to 85 degrees causing the boilers to run day and night. I think installing lock covers would solve the thermostat issues.
