TOPIC: Discussion of Community Survey and Related Levy/Bond Discussion

BACKGROUND: During the 2016-2017 School Year, a strategic planning team comprised of district staff and community members met to update the district's strategic plan. Three strategies were developed by the team:

- 1. We will enhance the Forest Lake Area Schools identity as a comprehensive academic, athletic, and arts educational leader resulting in high levels of community pride and support.
- 2. We will secure the financial and human resources necessary to support premier instructional, athletic, and arts programs and facilities.
- 3. We will ensure an effective and efficient transition to the new junior high and high school communities.

A community task force was developed to address the strategy related to resources. This team was led by Board Member Peterson. Two recommendations were made by this team:

- 1. Operating Referendum increasing the district's operating levy;
- 2. Bond Referendum to address outdoor athletic needs.

The school board asked for a community survey to assess community support for a proposed referendum and bond election. The survey was conducted by Morris-Leatherman.
