## 1. <u>Background:</u>

Noted in the Education Code Chapter 37. Discipline; Law and Order, representatives from surrounding County Districts, including Southwest ISD and Bexar County Juvenile Justice Academy, have developed a Memorandum of Understanding outlining responsibilities and parameters for BCJJAEP. This partnership is a requirement under Texas Education Code, Chapter 37.011-Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Program.

## 2. <u>Process:</u>

Noted in the Education Code Chapter 37.007 Discipline; Law and Order, students who violate the District's Student Code of Conduct under mandatory or discretionary regulations shall/may be assigned to the BCJJAEP at an approximate expense of \$135.85 per student per day.

3. Fiscal Impact:

The projected budget for BCJJAEP is approximately \$150,000.00.

## 4. <u>Recommendation:</u>

That the Board approve the 2025-2026 Memorandum of Understanding between the Bexar County Juvenile Board and Southwest ISD as presented.
