Dear Browning Public School Board Members,

I am writing to request approval for a scheduled weekend driving session as part of our Traffic Education Program. As required by the program, students must complete a “long drive” experience that includes both highway and interstate driving. To meet this requirement, we have planned a supervised instructional trip to Great Falls for our students. During a recent presentation from the Office of Public Instruction (OPI), it was clarified that any driving instruction conducted on weekends must receive prior approval from the school board. In accordance with this guidance, we are seeking approval for our students to complete their long drive on Saturday, May 16, 2026.
